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Administrative history / Biographical sketch

Trinity Lutheran College began in 1944 as the Lutheran Bible Institute of Seattle (LBIS). Based in Minneapolis, the Lutheran Bible Institute system established campuses in Seattle, WA (1944), Teaneck, New Jersey (1948), and Los Angeles, CA (1951). All three campuses eventually became independent. LBIS began operations out of Gethsemane Lutheran Church in downtown Seattle. In 1949, the Institute relocated to a campus on Greenwood Avenue in North Seattle. LBIS initially focused on one and two year education programs in biblical studies and youth ministry. Over time, educational offerings expanded and enrollment grew, necessitating another move in 1979. The Institute purchased land in Issaquah, WA, that had previously been the home of Providence Heights College, from the Sisters of Providence. In 1982, LBIS became accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities and expanded their offerings to include bachelors programs in traditional liberal arts areas such as education, communication, and music. To reflect the Institute's broad offerings and accredited status, the name was changed to Trinity Lutheran College in 1999. The College moved again in 2008, this time to the Port Gardner Building in downtown Everett, WA. Program offerings included 10 majors and 17 minors for Bachelors students, along with Certificate and Associate programs. That same year, the Trinity Education Foundation was established to provide financial support for Trinity students. In 2016, the College announced that they would cease operations. The final class graduated in May of that year. The Trinity Education Foundation continues to operate, now providing scholarship operations for students pursuing educational opportunities at faith-based institutions.

	<p>Item - The Challenger 1955</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>Pastor Alan Solmonson arrived the summer of 1974 to begin a new American Lutheran Church congregation in the Anchorage hillside area. After knocking on a great number of doors, he held the first service on October 6, 1974 at Kiel's Mortuary. Shortly thereafter, services were moved to Huffman Elementary School and the congregation was officially organized as Amazing Grace on Sunday, November 24, 1974. Groundbreaking for the present building was held in July of 1975. Bob Hawkinson, a congregation member, was the construction superintendent. Construction included a tremendous amount of volunteer labor. First services were held in the new building basement, with the congregation sitting on planks, Thanksgiving of 1975. The building was completed and dedicated April 25, 1976. The two "portables" Sunday School rooms were added in the fall of 1982. Pastor Solmonson departed in early 1978 and Don Parsons was installed May 21, 1978.</p>		
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1956</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>Central Lutheran was organized in the ELC on July 9, 1944 with fifty charter members. The first church was located at 6th Avenue and F Street. The present site was purchased in July of 1961, and the congregation began meeting in the unfinished church in April of 1965. May 18, 1969 marked the celebration of the congregation's 25th anniversary. On June 19, 1977, groundbreaking occurred for the new education wing, and dedication followed on May 14, 1978.</p>		
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1957</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>Under the direction of the Division of American Missions of the American Lutheran Church, Pastor Rodney L. Kastle began work in the Sand Lake area in November of 1965. The first worship services were conducted at Sand Lake Elementary School on January 30, 1966. Formally organizing on June 26, 1966, the new congregation extended a letter of call to Pastor Kastle. He served as a pastor until August of 1973. Pastor Richard A. Halvorson began work at Gloria Dei in February of 1974.</p>		
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1958</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>Future members of Saint Mark gathered for their first service on November 15, 1959. The congregation was organized on Palm Sunday, April 10, 1960 with 61 adults and 65 children. Floyd Brause was called</p>		

	<p>as the first pastor. In the early months, the new congregation organized a Luther League, women's organization and a couples club. Ground was broken for a first unit on August 6, 1961, and the first service was conducted there on November 26. The building was dedicated on March 11, 1962. A classroom addition was constructed in September of 1965 and a new church in 1969. Dedication of the new church was held on January 18, 1970.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1959</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>The first worship service of Christ Lutheran Church was on February 1, 1976 at University Park Elementary School and the first Sunday School classes were held on March 21, 1976. On May 16, 1976, the congregational Charter opened for signatures. May 30th of that first year, services were moved to Alaskaland for the summer. This was to become an annual tradition. On December 5, 1976, the congregation formally organized and the first council was elected. The ground-breaking for the new church building took place in July of 1979 and the first service was held there on December 23, 1979. The official dedication took place on Jan. 13, 1980.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1960</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>On June 7, 1944, Rev. James O. Pederson and Rev. Selmer T. Nelson arrived in Fairbanks to establish a congregation for the Evangelical Lutheran Church. The Fairbanks Lutheran Church congregation was organized August 18, 1944. Services were started, Sunday School was held, the Ladies' Aid was organized, property was purchased (at 521 4th Ave.), a church was erected, and a pastor was called. The decision to relocate was made in the fall of 1957. In 1959, a parsonage on the new property was constructed, and the church was erected in 1960 and 1961. The office wing was built in 1971.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1961</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>The Rev. Floyd Brause became the mission developer in 1972. The first service was held on October 14, 1973 in the Homestead Elementary School with 91 people present. A Sunday School was organized one month later with 35 children. In April of 1974 a store front building was rented in the downtown area. Folding chairs were purchased and altar furnishings constructed by men of the congregation. The congregation remained in this building for two years. In the spring of 1976, the congregation moved to the Eagle River Elementary School. Groundbreaking was held for a new building in September of 1976. Construction was completed in April of 1977, although the congregation moved into the unfinished building on Christmas Eve, 1976. An active duty day care center began in 1977 with the aid of a municipal grant. Construction began in May, 1984 for an addition to the first building. The addition houses offices, extra classrooms, a large pre-school area with office space, an enlarged nave, and increased spaces.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1962</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>Resurrection was, in one sense, the rebirth of Immanuel Lutheran of Douglas. In 1900 Dr. S. P. Lindahl was sent to explore the gold field of Alaska. On his recommendation, work was begun on Douglas Island, with Juneau and Skagway as auxiliary stations. The congregation organized in 1912. A cave-in at Treadwell Mine caused many members to move away. By 1920, the congregation ceased to exist. Field missionary Perry Baisler began conducting services again in July of 1924. Resurrection was formally organized on Easter Sunday, April 11, 1926. The first pastor was Rev. Harry Allen who arrived September 26, 1926. Congregants purchased an old cigar factory and renovated it for the church. The Rev. John Cauble arrived June 1, 1937 and served until October 12, 1941. In 1940, he helped reorganize the Sitka Lutheran Church which had been founded in 1840. The church operated a fisherman's center and community hospital. In 1953, property was purchased and ground was broken in May of the following year. A new church was dedicated on November 12, 1954 with nearly 1,000 in attendance. Groundbreaking for a new church took place on October 6, 1974 with the first services on October 5, 1975. Formal dedication was held October 12, 1975.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1963</p>

	<p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>The Norwegian Lutheran Church of America in 1923 established a Seamen's Home at Ketchikan. In September of 1923 the Ladies' Aid was established as a service auxiliary for the Seamen's home, continuing as a church auxiliary after the Seamen's Home was sold. The auxiliary continues today as the First Lutheran Church Women. On August 18, 1925 First Lutheran church was organized. In 1930 the church was erected at 1200 Tongass Avenue.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1964</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>St. Paul Lutheran Church has roots that go back to 1967, when a number of pastors from the Anchorage area to the Kodiak area to conduct services for interested families. Rev. Ernest Johnson of Bristol, South Dakota, was called in September of 1968 to serve as pastor. The congregation was officially organized the following April. Arrangements were made to use the facilities of the St. James Fisherman Episcopal congregation. In 1977, the congregation constructed a new church facilities which included the sanctuary, classrooms, offices, and fellowship hall.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1965</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>Rev. and Mrs. Tollef L. Brevig began their ministry at the Teller Reindeer Station on August 1, 1984. On his trips throughout the Seward Peninsula, Rev. Brevig occasionally stopped at Nome and held Lutheran worship services. This practice was continued by subsequent missionaries. In 1943, there began a migration to Nome of Lutheran Eskimos from Mary's Igloo, Shishmaref, Brevig Mission, and Teller, and work of a more permanent nature became necessary. Dr. Philip S. Dybvig, executive director of Home Missions for the ELC, authorized the Rev. Norval Hegland, superintendent of Lutheran Eskimo Missions, to purchase lots and a quanset hut for use as a temporary chapel. The first service was conducted on September 20, 1953. Our Savior's Congregation was formally organized January 21, 1957, and the new church was dedicated October 30, 1960. These units were completely funded as a national project by the Women's Missionary Federation.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1966</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>In April of 1975 Lowell Stime was called as Assistant Pastor of Fairbanks Lutheran Church and organizing pastor at North Pole. The first service there was held on June 15, 1975. Organization Sunday was October 26, 1975, and in February of 1976 there was reception of 101 charter members. The summer of 1976 was spent building a parsonage and beginning a church facility. Groundbreaking ceremonies were held July 18. The congregation used the unfinished church for special services until they moved there on a permanent basis on May 1, 1977. Dedication of the completed structure took place October 30, 1977, which also marked the Second Anniversary of the congregation.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1967</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>The congregation was established in 1913. The first church building was purchased from a local Presbyterian mission organization.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1968</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>The Seward town site was settled and named in 1903, and the first Lutheran family on record, Mr. and Mrs. John Rosness, arrived in 1905 and were charter members of the church. In 1917 a dozen people gathered for occasional worship and purchased two city lots for a church. Traveling pastors from Juneau stopped by twice annually to conduct services. The congregation was formally organized in October of 1945. The first full-time pastor was Kent Spaulding, who served from 1949-1952.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1969</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p>

	<p>In 1928 the Lutheran Daughters of the Reformation provided funds to begin a mission. The original name of the congregation was the Anna M. Huseh Memorial Mission. First services were held in August of 1930 by Rev. E. H. Dahle, under whose direction the original building was completed. This building and the parsonage were destroyed by fire in 1984. A new building and parsonage were built in the summer of 1985. This was funded and built by thousands of dollars contributed by the congregations in the district, and construction was done by volunteer laborers who came from many congregations in the Northwest. The new building seated approximately 400, which nearly totaled the population of the village at that time.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1970</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>Rev. Uno Cygnaeus arrived in Sitka in May of 1840, having been sent by the Church of Finland to establish the first non-orthodox church in Russian America. Aided in this endeavor by the Governor, who was also a Finnish Lutheran, he and the others soon had a flourishing church with approximately 150 members, most of whom were Finnish craftsmen, clerks and shipwrights. In October of 1867, Alaska was formally transferred to the United States. The departure of the Russian Company left Sitka Lutheran with few members. The building was dismantled and the furnishings placed in storage. For 50 years the plot of land "given to the Lutheran Congregation in perpetuity" had no building. Then, in 1940, the ULC refounded the Sitka Church on the site. On January 2, 1966 fire destroyed the church and much of downtown Sitka. The new building was dedicated in 1967.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1971</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>A small grant was made by the ALC for the purpose of establishing a Lutheran congregation in Soldotna. Pastors Glenn Groth and O. B. Fjelstad of nearby congregations in Anchorage and Seward served the congregation for almost a year. Ground was broken for the church on September 10, 1962. The congregation was formally organized February 2, 1963.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1972</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>The date for organization is 1949, but work there began many years before, about the same time as the Brevig Mission in 1894. Missionaries from Brevig often serve the people of Teller. The church building began as a saloon and restaurant during the gold rush of the late 1800s, and for many years was used as a warehouse before being sold to the church.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1973</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>Epiphany grew out of Pastor Eric Ottum's Alaskan Ministry and in cooperation with the local Episcopal Church. The first Lutheran service was held in the Episcopal Church of the Epiphany and was attended by 25 people.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1974</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>The congregation in the community of Wales has roots in the congregation mission which was established July 4, 1890. It was re-established as a Presbyterian mission in 1921. In 1954 the mission was transferred to the Covenant Church until 1971, when congregation voted to join Lutheran Church and was admitted to ALC in 1973.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1975</p> <p><i>Note [General] :</i></p> <p>Good Shepherd started as a mission congregation in the fall of 1978. Six families met in the Presbyterian Church, later moving to the public library. Ground was broken on April 27, 1981, and construction completed in 1982.</p>
	<p>Item - The Challenger 1976</p>
