Boys Accused of Three Parkland Burglaries

A junior crime wave hit Parkland and vicinity early Thursday morning, Aug. 16, when two juvenile delinquents burglarized Parkland Western Auto Store, Shamrock Tavern and Smith's Corner Market. The young boys accused of the offense are said to be local lads, one only 13 years of age.

At Parkland Western Auto, the loot included \$150 in cash and a 22 rifle. At Shamrock Tavern, in addition to more than \$100 in cash, the boys took cigarettes, wine and beer.

Theft at Smith's Market was trivial in comparison to property damage, the young thugs apparently taking delight in wanton destruction. They broke two neon lights, broke pop and grape juice bottles and smashed dishes stored in the back of the store. They also hacked woodwork and equipment with the butcher's cleaver and threw tomatoes all over the market. They stole cigarettes and candy.

It is reported that the two young burglars have been taken into custody and Chief Criminal Deputy Dick McCreadie of the Pierce county sheriff's office reports the recovery of nearly \$500 in loot taken from the three business houses.

JR. DAIRY SHOW TO BE FEATURED ON FAIR PROGRAM

Washington's greatest array of junior-owned dairy cattle, numbering more than 400 head and having a total valuation of \$130,000, will be displayed at the Washington Junior Dairy show to be held at Puyallup during the 48th annual Western Washington fair, Sept. 15 to 23.

Secretary-Manager J. H. McMurray declares that this is the first time that the 4-H and Future Farmers' organizations have combined to stage a giant show and that this will be the only junior dairy show of this magnitude in the Puget Sound country.

Premiums for the show, one of four official youth shows having state recognition, will total approximately \$7,000. Quality of the show will be extremely high, McMurray points out, for only animals that have won blue ribbons at county and district fairs, will be exhibited at Puyallup.

Entries will come from all over the state and will be principally of the Guernsey, Jersey and Holstein breeds.

"This show means that livestock entries by 4-H and Future Farmer exhibitors this year," McMurray said, "will be just double in number over any previous show at Puyallup. Exhibitors in the adult classes will be pressed, for the young showmen are out to steal the show."

Actually, the show will be two shows in one, with the 4-H and Future Farmer groups staging their own competition. Judges named by County Agent Claude Doran, head of the fair's 4-H department, will be Lennis Hall of Carnation Farms, Tim Blasser, and Dr. Al Shaw, both of the dairy department from Washington State college.

Judges in the F. F. A. classification will be Dr. J. C. Knott, WSC; Frank Myers, Olympia Guernsey breeder, and Ted Britten, former vocational teacher from Snohomish. In charge of F. F. A. activities at the fair is Dick Olsen of Olympia.

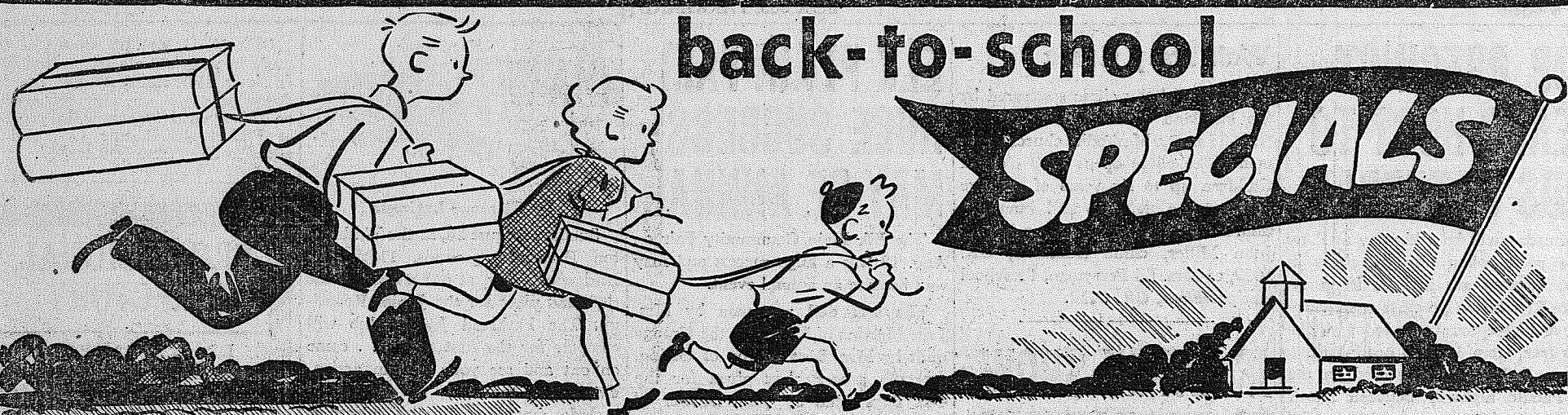

Recipe of the Week

Carrot Pineapple Salad
1/2 cup pineapple juice, 1/2 cup water, 1/2 pkg. lemon gelatin, 3-oz. pkg. white cream cheese, 1/2 cup finely shredded carrots, 1/2 cup canned crushed pineapple, 1 tablespoon vinegar, 1/2 cup Fat Milk.

Heat pineapple juice and water to boiling. Add gelatin; stir until dissolved. Cool to room temperature. Rub with vegetable oil a mold or bowl holding about 4 cups. Meanwhile mix cheese, carrots, pineapple and vinegar. Stir milk into gelatin. Then stir in cheese mixture. Pour into mold or bowl. Chill until firm. Serve on lettuce. Makes 4 servings.
