Preparations are in full swing at Pacific Lutheran college for the third annual drama-music festival to be held May 6 to 9. A student cast of 22 is rehearsing daily on the play, "Joan of Lorraine," which will be presented May 7 with Luise Rainer.

Miss Rainer, a two-time Academy award winner for her parts in motion pictures, will arrive on the campus Wednesday.

Under the direction of Prof. Gunnar J. Malmin, the 125 voice festival chorus is holding daily rehearsals. The group will sing in two concerts May 8 with the Seattle Symphony orchestra.
