| People who have been saying that Parkland is one of the fastest growing communities in the state had their suspicions confirmed this week by unofficial census returns, which showed tremendous increases in population for the whole South End. <br> Parkland is unofficially credited with a population of 8,138 , an increase of nearly 5,000 since the last decennial census. Spanaway-Elk Plain has a total of 3,652 residents, while Harvard-Midland boasts a figure of 3,521 . <br> Tentative figures for enumeration districts in central Pierce County were released by crew leaders, Freeman Cochran and E. J. Shumacher, and compiled by the Parkland Times. | Boundaries were based roughly on school and fire districts. <br> Parkland's' 8,138 figure includes everything between 96 th $S t$. and Orchard Hill, from Sprague St. (bordering McChord Field) east to McKinley Ave. and Golden Givens. If Parkland were ever to incorporate, however, it is doubtful that more than four or five thousand would be included within the corporate limits. The rest are scattered along the fringes of the sprawling suburb and next to the Tacoma city limits. <br> Spanaway's total includes the area east of the military reservation between Orchard Hill south to the Muck-Kapowsin Road. This rectangle, embracing only a quarter of a square mile, has 1,117 people living in 337 houses. <br> Largest populated enumeration district was in the Allison-Collins area, parts of which are claimed by Parkland and Midland. In the area between Golden Givens and Canyon Road, between Knapp and Brookdale Road and Collins Road, no less than 1,705 people are settled, most of them on small subsistence farms. <br> Parkland's" total includes about 350 college students, who live in the community through nine months of the year. <br> Throughout the South End, there is | an approximate ratio of three persons per dwelling unit. For instance, in the rectangle between Airport Road and 116 th St. in Parkland, there are 301 houses and 910 people. <br> It should be emphasized that none of these figures can be considered official. The local crew leaders merely released tentative totals for 20 South End enumeration districts which the Times used to figure out populations of the larger communities in the area. <br> Several of the local enumerators asked the Times to relay to its readers a word of appreciation for wonderful co-operation with the 1950 census. One of them commented that everyone she contacted treated her like an old friend. |
