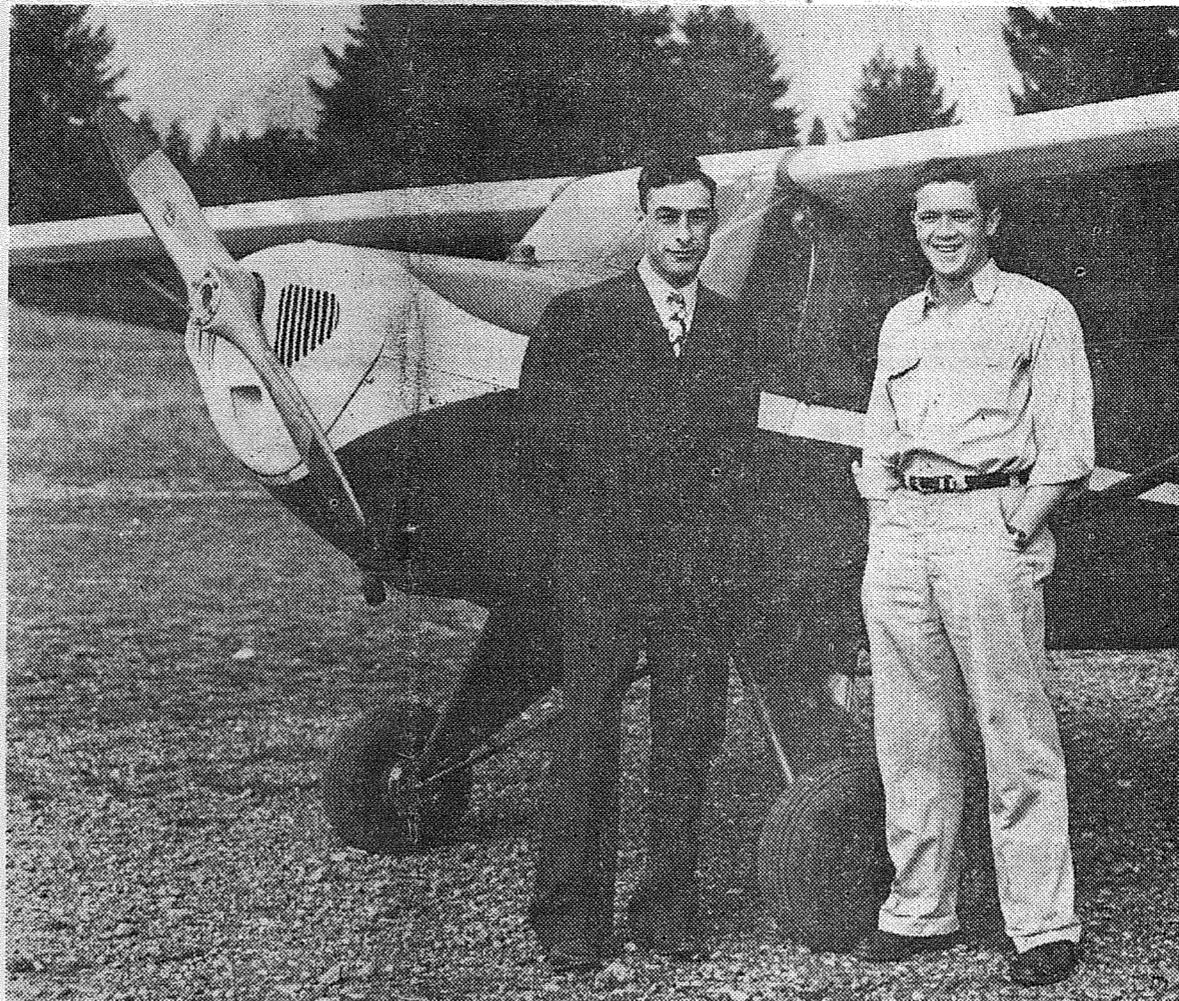
FIREMEN AUXILIARY OPEN FALL SEASON

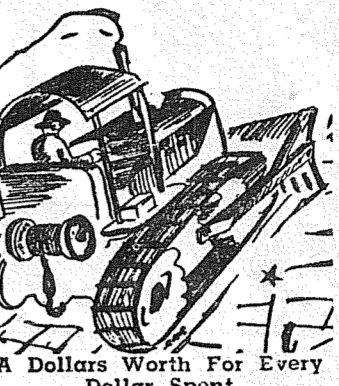

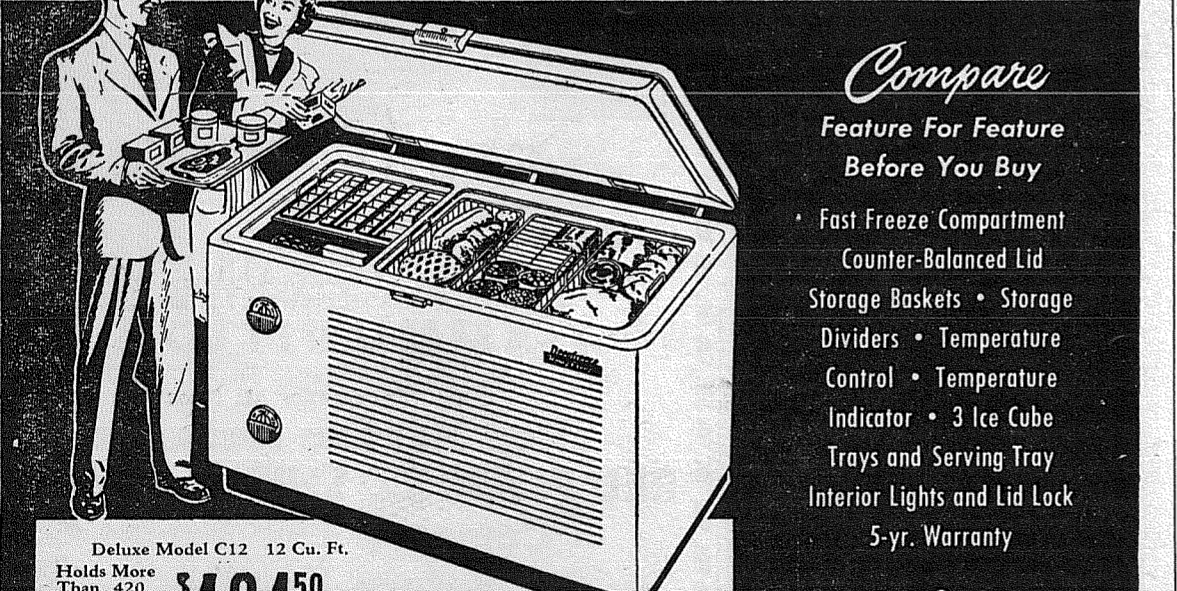

Supper Salad
 1/2 cup bottled salad dressing or mayonnaise
 1/2 cup Pet Milk
 1/2 teaspoon salt
 1/2 teaspoon pepper
 1 teaspoon grated onion
 2 teaspoons finely cut parsley (can omit)
 2 teaspoons vinegar
 1 1/2 cups drained canned peas
 1 cup diced cheese
 1/2 cup diced celery

Mix salad dressing, milk, salt, pepper, onion and parsley. Stir in vinegar. Mix well, then chill. At serving time, mix with peas, cheese and celery. Serve on lettuce or other salad greens, if desired. Makes 4 servings.
