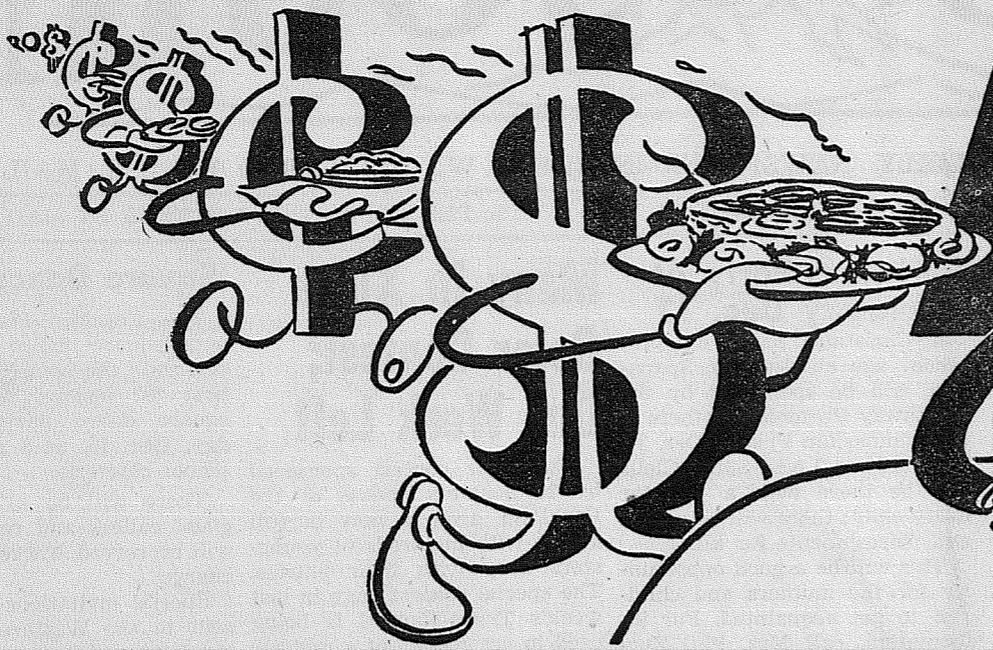

**Date Filled Squares**

1 1/2 cups cut-up dates 1/4 teaspoon baking soda  
 1/2 cup Pet Evaporated Milk 1/2 teaspoon salt  
 1/4 cup water 1/2 cup soft shortening  
 2 Tablespoons sugar 1/2 cup brown sugar  
 1 cup sifted, all-purpose flour 3/4 cup rolled oats

Mix in a saucepan the dates, milk, water and sugar. Cook and stir over medium heat until thickened. Remove from heat. Let stand until needed. Sift together onto a piece of paper the flour, baking soda and salt. Put shortening into a 2-qt. bowl. Mix in brown sugar until light and fluffy. Stir in flour mixture and rolled oats. Press half of the oat mixture firmly in the bottom of a greased 8-in. square pan. Spread date mixture over top. Sprinkle rest of the oat mixture evenly over date mixture. Press gently into date mixture with back of spoon. Bake on rack slightly below center in 400 oven (hot) for 30 minutes, or until light brown. Cool about 10 minutes, then cut into 2-inch squares. Makes 16.

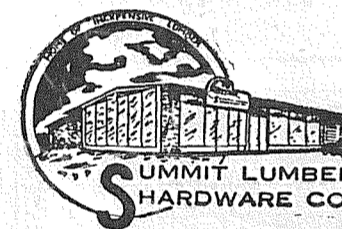

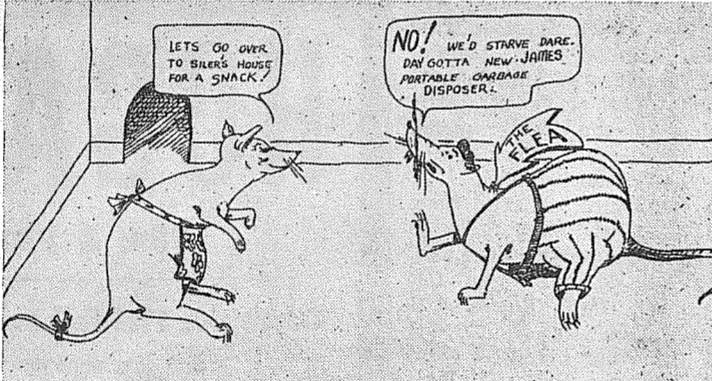

## County Agent's Corner

I have often heard a farmer say "It looks silly to buy fuel for heating when I have acres in brush and trees. The fact

is I haven't time to saw, haul and split wood."

C. M. Quist of Puyallup is manufacturing a wood burning home heating hot air furnace that may solve this land owners problem. Last week in company with a couple of foresters, Knut Lunnum of Washington State College and Walt Thompson of Portland we made a call for a demonstration of this new

furnace. The advantages seem to be in the use of 6 or 7 foot scrap wood material posts, lumber timber thinnings green or dry. Stoking at 12 hour intervals Quist says keeps steady heat circulating. The new furnace seems to use the principle of the old air tight heater with better air control and more complete combustion. Due to the angle of the fire box the long material keeps burning off and sliding down to keep the fire glowing away.

The principle of conserving and using our natural resources of the land has received a boost for even the busy farmer with promotion of this new type wood furnace. Part-time farmers or families moving out in the country to cut living costs may find the Quist development fitting in with their objectives.

Hot house rhubarb farmers may want to take a look at this new burner too.

The demonstration we saw proved effective. Walt Thompson departed for Portland with a pocket full of specifications for installing a wood burning hot air furnace in his new country home.

I would suggest those with only a few trees use puritized agricultural spray at the rate of 3 liquid ounces to 5 gallons of water which is 4 teaspoonsful to one gallon of water. This dilution is at the rate of 2 qts. of the puritized to 100 gallons of water.

Commercially any of the following are recommended for the control of the curl as well as the one mentioned above. Bordeaux-6-6-50; Fermate-3 lbs. to 100 gallons of water; Phynon 1 lb. to 100 gallons of water. Just be sure to apply one of these ingredients.
