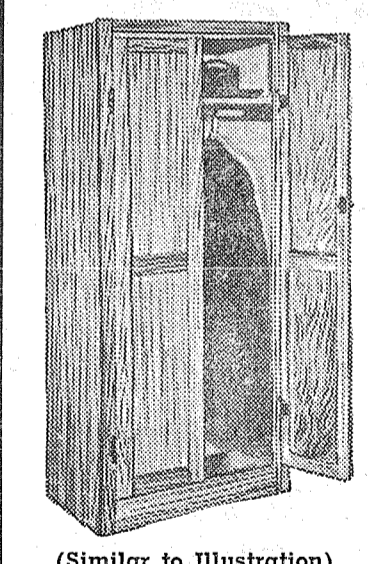

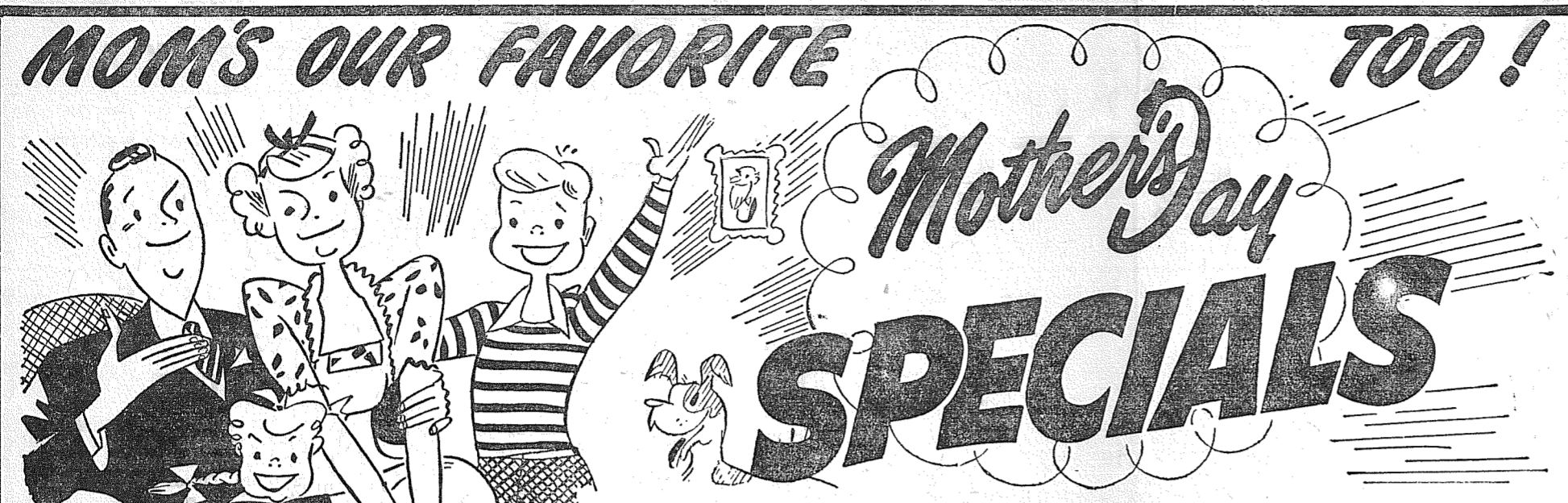

By Mary Lee Taylor  
**Raisin Tapioca Pudding**  
Broadcast: May 13, 1950  
1 egg, separated 1/2 cup Pet Milk  
1/2 cup brown sugar 1/4 cup seedless raisins  
2 tablespoons quick-cooking tapioca 1 teaspoon vanilla  
few grains salt 2 marshmallows,  
1/2 cup water 2 teaspoons jelly  
Beat egg white until stiff, but not dry.  
Beat in 1/4 cup brown sugar. Mix in  
saucepan the tapioca, 1/4 cup brown  
sugar, the salt and water. Boil over  
low heat 5 min., or until tapioca is  
clear and thick. Stir in slowly a mix-  
ture of slightly beaten egg yolk, milk  
and raisins. Stir to a boil over low  
heat, then boil and stir 30 seconds  
longer. Take off heat; add vanilla.  
Fold in egg-white mixture. Put into  
4 dessert dishes. Chill. At serving  
time, garnish with marshmallow  
halves. Top each marshmallow with  
equal parts of jelly.

**Grass Seeders Now Available**

Two grass seeder drills have been secured by the Pierce

County Soil Conservation District, said Mr. Harlan Ford, Chairman, Board of Supervisors. The drills will be used by farmers to carry out soil conservation practices such as green manuring, cover-crops and long-lived legume and grass seeding where good equipment is necessary. He further stated that the equipment would be rented to those farmers co-operating with

the Soil Conservation District. For details about use of this equipment see the following Soil Conservation Supervisors: Guy Mains, Lakebay; Joel Olson, River Road; Mervin Ward, Alderton; Clarence Bement, Eatonville; and Mr. Ford, Orting.

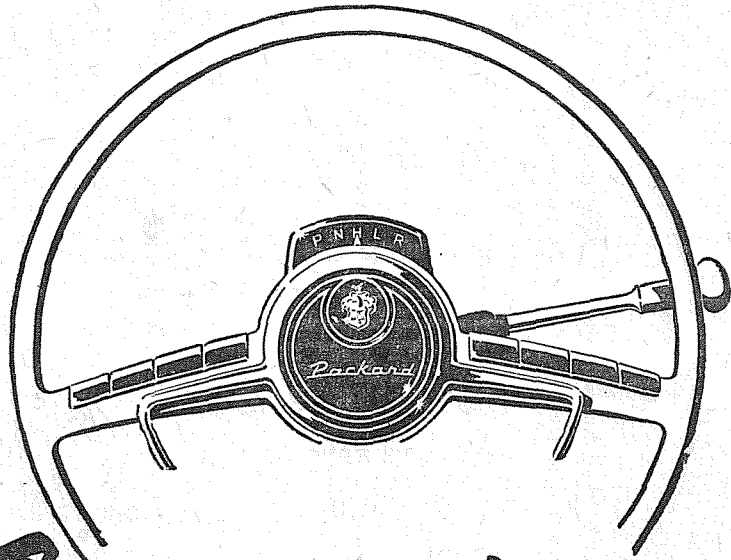
One of the drills is an 8 foot double disc, with a fertilizer attachment. Mr. Ford added that the disc on this drill had metal bands to control the placement depth of the seed sown. The other seeder is what is commonly called a packer-seeder. This type seeder is similar to a multi-packer with grass seeding and fertilizer attachment mounted on top of the rollers. This type of seeder, he said, is not commonly used in this District, but has proven successful in other areas.
