Employer Health Insurance Reimbursement Plans (Government Penalty)

Does your congregation reimburse staff for health insurance premiums on a plan purchased by the staff themselves? If so, you are not complying with the Affordable Care Act (ACA) and may be subject to penalties of \$100 per day, per employee. This could cost your congregation \$36,500 per year per employee, and you should stop offering health premium reimbursements as soon as possible. 
God's Work. Our Hands. September 13, 2015
