Five years ago the ELCA joined worldwide efforts to fight malaria by launching the ELCA Malaria Campaign. Our goal: \$15 million by 2015. Today, we're 94 percent of the way there. The congregations and individuals of the Alaska Synod, as of the end of April, have contributed over \$40,918.04 to the Malaria Campaign. That is an average of over \$4 per baptized ELCA Alaskan. 
