Fairbanks Lutheran Church Flooding

The Scriptures say that rain falls equally on the just and the unjust, and Fairbanks can attest to this as they have had a record summer for rainfall.

Fairbanks Lutheran, like many of their neighbors, are trying to manage flooding in their basement.

Volunteers, working literally around the clock, have managed to keep the flooding to a few inches, move stored items and provide snacks for the workers.



The insurance carrier for the church states that groundwater seepage does not constitute flooding, so at least initially, the damage is not covered by insurance. Please keep their church and community in your prayers as they struggle to clean up and reorganize.

2015 Contribution Summary

Contributions paid by sponsoring employers:

- ELCA-Primary health -- contribution amount will increase by 11% for each of the four health benefit options (Platinum+, Gold+, Silver+, Bronze+) and will also be adjusted due to changes in age and defined compensation
- ELCA Medicare-Primary health -- will increase by 11% for the Standard option, and will also be adjusted due to changes in age and defined compensation
- Disability -- will be reinstated after one-year suspension, set at 2.5% of defined compensation
- Survivor -- no change; will remain 0.8% of defined compensation
- Retiree support -- no change; will remain 0.7% of defined compensation

- Retirement -- no change to required minimum amounts
