"Yellow Pages" Scam Targets Church Admins

New and Seasoned Church Administrators should be aware of a regular scam that often comes by fax. The scammers, American Yellow Group, Inc., use an old Yellow Pages "walking finger logo" and send a bill demanding payment for a Yellow Pages listing. They often threaten credit damaging action if payment is not made. Do not reply to the fax. You may report the scam to the Better Business Bureau. bbb.org. 
