

The beauty and grandeur of Norway, with her lofty mountains, deep blue fjords and wood clad valleys, inspired such masters as Grieg, Bull, Sinding, Paulsen, Kjerulf, and many others, to express themselves in song and music. They contributed compositions of lasting beauty that rightfully belong among the finest the world has produced.

From the days of the Vikings, to our present time, singing has been considered a national heritage of the Norwegian people. In virtually every town and village in Norway there is a singing society, with male choruses having an important place in the musical life of the nation.

In America, as in Norway, the characteristic Norwegian love of singing and the ability to organize has manifested itself, which has forged a strong link in the bond between those of Norwegian birth and ancestry with the homeland.

For over sixty five years, Norwegian singing societies have existed on the west coast. The Pacific Coast Norwegian Singers Association was organized in Seattle, Washington, in 1902, with the first Sangerfest being held in Everett, Washington, in 1903. Since then Sangerfests have been celebrated in the principal cities of the Pacific Coast.

The present Sangerfest is the 60th in the history of the Pacific Coast Norwegian Singers Association, and the third to be held here in Southern California.





IN MEMORIAM

1869 — Rudolph H. Moller — 1969

Composer — Director

Rudolph Moller was elected Director-in-Chief of the Pacific Coast Norwegian Singers Association in 1916, which position he held until his death in 1935.

In 1926 he was the Director of the Norway Chorus, consisting of 48 male singers, from the Pacific Coast, which concertized across the United States and to and through Norway, giving a total of 47 concerts.

In 1930 he was decorated by His Majesty King Haakon VII of Norway, receiving the St. Olav's Ridder Ordenen av Forste Klasse.

Rudolph Moller composed many songs for male choruses which have brought him distinction, both in Norway and America. His work and influence among Norwegian people will long be remembered; we therefore honor this, the 100th Anniversary of his birth.

Henry Ringman joined the Norwegian Male Chorus of Everett, Washington, and became their director in 1923. He continued in this capacity until his death, February 6, 1969.

He received the St. Olav Medal, in 1962, from His Majesty King Olav V of Norway, for his outstanding work in promoting Norwegian culture and music.

Henry Ringman was a staunch supporter of the Pacific Coast Association in all their endeavors. His enthusiasm and active work was a shining example of a true Singer, friend and man. His death has left a void in the ranks of the Sanger-Forbund.
