THE BEAUTY AND GRANDEUR of Norway, with her lofty mountains, deep blue fjords and woodclad valleys, inspired such masters as Grieg, Ole Bull, Sinding, Kjerulf, Nordraak, Reissiger, Borg and many others to express themselves in song and music. They contributed compositions of lasting beauty that rightfully belong among the finest the world has produced. Singing has been the heritage of the Norwegian people since the days of the Vikings. In towns, villages and farm lands singing societies were formed for young and old and it was in Norway that male chorus a cappella singing was developed to the high level which has been used universally throughout the years.

In America, as in Norway, the characteristic Norwegian love of song and the ability to organize has manifested itself in male chorus work which has forged a strong link in the bond between those of Norwegian birth and those of Norwegian ancestry.

To further the culture of group singing on the Pacific Coast, representatives of various choruses met in Seattle in 1902 and organized the Pacific Coast Norwegian Singers Association.

The first Sangerfest was held in the City of Everett in 1903. This is the fifty-ninth Sangerfest and the eighth held in the City of Everett.

Brief History of Everett

Captain George Vancouver sailed into Puget Sound in April, 1792 and landed on a high bluff above the water on what is now North Grand Avenue Park, between 16th and 19th streets. For 70 years after this landing, nothing happened. Then in 1862, the first settler, Dennis Brigham, took a homestead. The next settler was Erskine Kromer who took a homestead just south of Brigham. In June, 1891 Henry Hewitt, an eastern financier, bought 140 acres of waterfront from John Hilton for \$10 and other considerations. These considerations were promises to start some industries in this area. He was instrumental in getting a paper mill, The Everett Pulp and Paper Co., a barge works, and a nails works, on the water front. Other financiers such as Rucker Brothers, Colby, Wetmore, Rockefeller, Oaks and McDougal became interested in the new city and today each one has a street named after them. The city got its name from Everett Colby, the son of Charles Colby, and the main street in Everett was named after Henry Hewitt. When the city was platted there was a steady stream of settlers and it grew rapidly in the pioneer days.

Everett has enjoyed a steady growth in industrial activity through the years and in 1966 Boeing announced plans to build the 747 in a new plant at Paine field in Everett. Everett has since shown all the signs of a boom town. People are flocking here from all over the country and whereas the last census shows Everett's population as approximately 60,000, today the greater Everett area has a population of 216,000. Many new buildings have been erected, two of the most prominent being the new Court House with the Plaza and the Seattle First National Bank eight story building.

It is interesting to note that many Norwegians have played an important roll in the city's growth, who were members of the Everett Norwegian Male Chorus. To mention a few, John Norman, first president of the association, Martin Clausen, who was treasurer of the Everett chorus for many years, Carl Jesdahl, Peter Vikdal, Carl Langland, Matt Forde, Rev. Carl Norgaard, Dr. O. P. Opsvig, Sigurd Holman and many more.

Program Notes

SONNER AV NORGE, text by H. A. Bjerregaard (1792-1842). Music by C. Blom (1782-1861). The song has been called "Den Kronede Norske Nationalsang" — The Crowned Norwegian National Song.

SHENANDOAH, Canoeing Song of Canadian Voyageurs and American Riverman. Originally not a sea shanty although often used as such. There are several variations both of text and melody.

VARDE. Poem by Per Sivle (1857-1904). He wrote several versions of the text. Music by J. Haarklou (1847-1925).

VARDE. "The Beacon" is one of the most popular songs in the repertoire of Norwegian Male Chorus music.

SANTUS. By F. Schubert (1797-1828). Number 5 of a collection of 8 male choruses called a German Mass. Composed in 1827 the year before he died.

O, IRIS AND OSIRIS. Chorus of priests from the opera "The Magic Flute", text by Schikaneder (1748-1812). Music by W. A. Mozart (1756-1791).

MAISANG. Original German text by J. Voss, translator unknown. Music by D. Kuhlav (1786-1832). (Kuhlav also composed a melody to SONNER AV NORGE.

ULABRAND. Text by Rosenkrantz Johnsen. Music by K. Wendelborg (1863-1938). The song eulogizing the famous pilot Anders Johannessen Ula, popularly called Ulabrand.

LUGN HVILAR SJON. German text by the composer H. Pfeil. Swedish translator unknown.

JUBILATE. Original text by the Irish poet, Thomas Moore (1779-1852). Music by Halfdan Kjerult (1815-1868).

HOR OSS, SVEA! Text and music by Gunnar Wennerberg, (1817-1901). Patriotic Swedish song.

BAADN-LAAT. Norwegian nursery ditty from Valdres freely arranged for male chorus by Edward Grieg (1843-1907).

LANDKJENDING. Text by Bjornson (1837-1910). Music by Grieg (1843-1907)
Text and music composed and sung for the first time 17th of May, 1872 by the students and Handelstrandens Male Choruses.

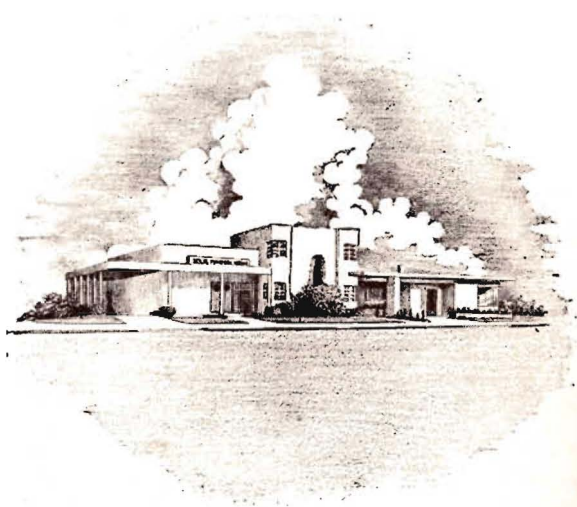

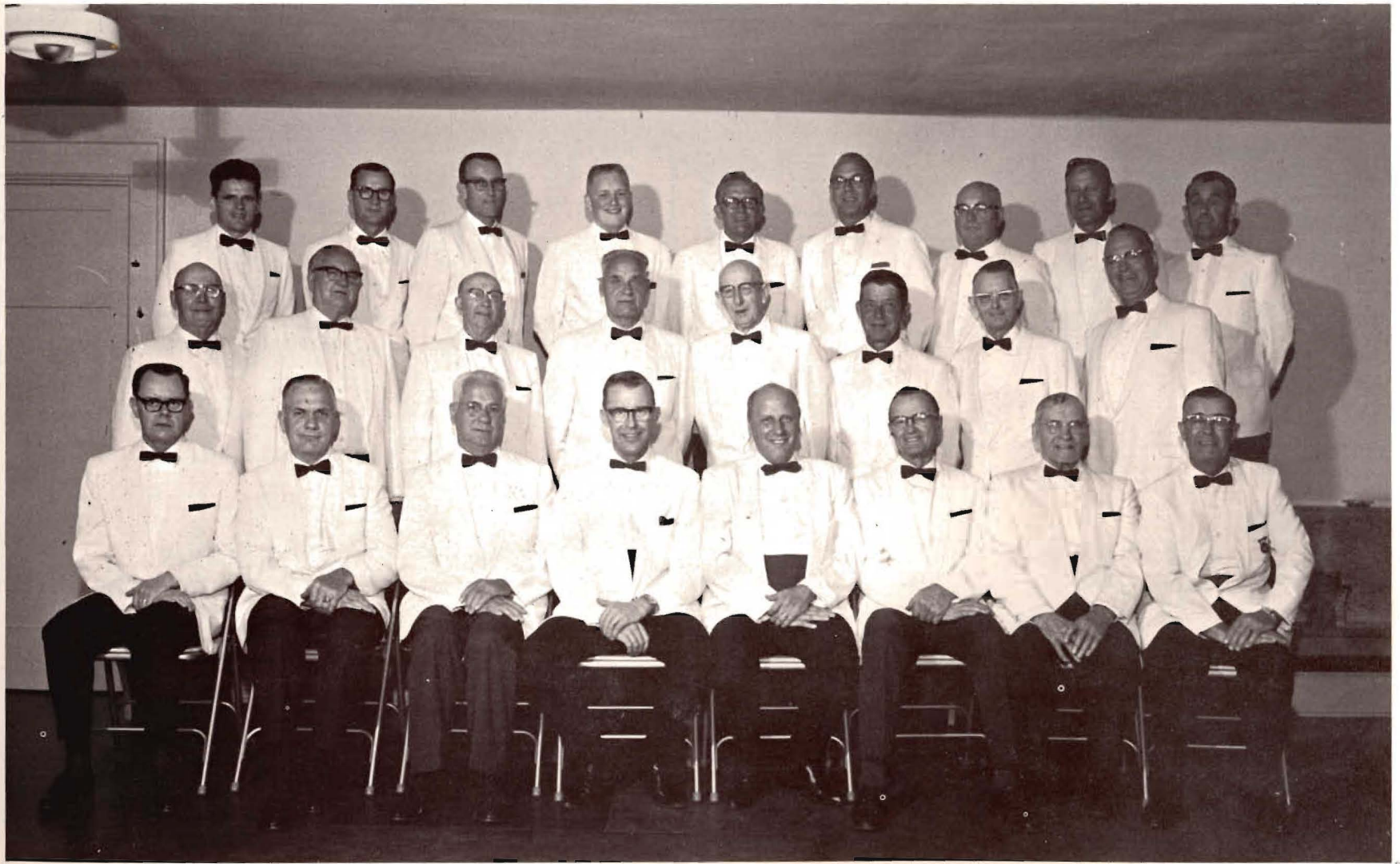
