





Founded in 1981 EBQ is an award winning ensemble performing concerts throughout the Northwest. The quintet is well known for its educational and entertaining school programs. EBQ has received grants for educational programs from the Tacoma Arts Commission, the Pierce County Arts Commission, the Cheney Foundation, and presently performs educational programs and residencies as a part of the Washington State Arts Commission's "Arts In Education" and "Rural Residency" programs.

The quintet has appeared as a part of Main Street and Harbor Days in Olympia, Centrum in Port Townsend, The Canterbury Faire in Kent, Bumbershoot in Seattle, Summer Pops! in Tacoma, and the "Rainy Day Festival" for pre-school children in Hoquiam. On a more formal note the quintet has performed at the State Capitol Museum in Olympia, Saint Thomas Episcopal Church in Medina, Holy Trinity Church in Port Angeles, Seattle First Presbyterian Church, Seattle Public Library, the King County Public Libraries, the Pierce County Public Libraries, the Camerata Musica in Richland and the Tacoma Art Museum. Networking with other artists the quintet has performed Tchaikovsky's "Nutcracker" with the

Carter Family Marionettes and a series of Brass and Organ programs at Christ Episcopal Church in Tacoma, St. Mary's Episcopal Church in Lakewood, Mason Methodist Church in Tacoma and appeared on the Sacred Music Series at the Seattle First Presbyterian Church in Seattle. Under the sponsorship of the Metropolitan Parks Department of Tacoma the quintet presents performances of "Teddy Bears' Picnic" at Never Never Land in Point Defiance Park in Tacoma. "Teddy Bears Picnic" has become a favorite for grades K–2. EBQ is the founder of the Northwest Ensemble Festival for music students.

EBQ recently initiated a mentor program for Jr. and Sr. High School brass quintets. The program involves a six week period of intensive coaching by one or more members of the quintet. The project culminates with a formal program shared with the Evergreen Brass.

Formal and less formal concerts, school programs, clinics and seminars presented in a relaxed and communicative manner are EBQ's trademarks. With their consummate musicianship, contagious warmth, and enthusiastic spirit, the Evergreen Brass Quintet attracts audiences as varied as the music they perform.

Our ladies we adore.




A special note about *PRAYER OF THE CHILDREN*: This moving song was written in 1995 by Kurt Bestor and arranged by Andrea Klouse, a local music author and teacher. This poignant piece is about the children in Bosnia and their fear of the turmoil in their country. The words are, "Can you hear the prayer of the children on bended knee, in the shadow of an unknown room? Empty eyes with no more tears to cry... Crying, "who will help me to see the morning light of one more day?" But if I should die before I wake, I pray my soul to take... Can you hear the voice of the children, softly pleading for silence in their shattered world? Angry guns preach a gospel full of hate, blood of the innocent on their hands, crying, "Jesus, help me to feel the sun upon my face". For when darkness clears, I know you're here, bringing peace again. Dalicujete, sve dfecje molitve. Can you hear the *PRAYER OF THE CHILDREN*?"
