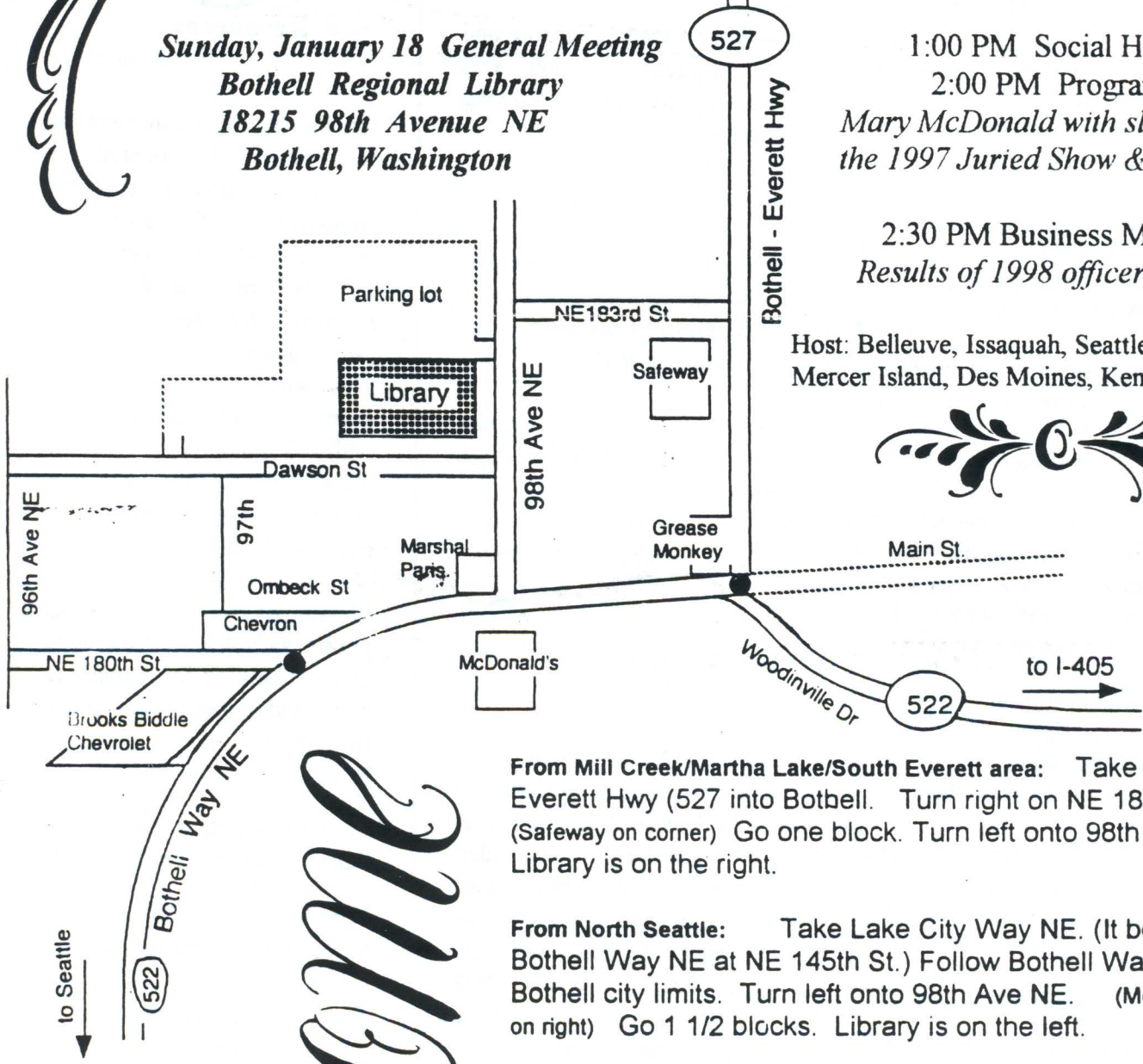

2:00 Bar opens – weiners & coffeecakes

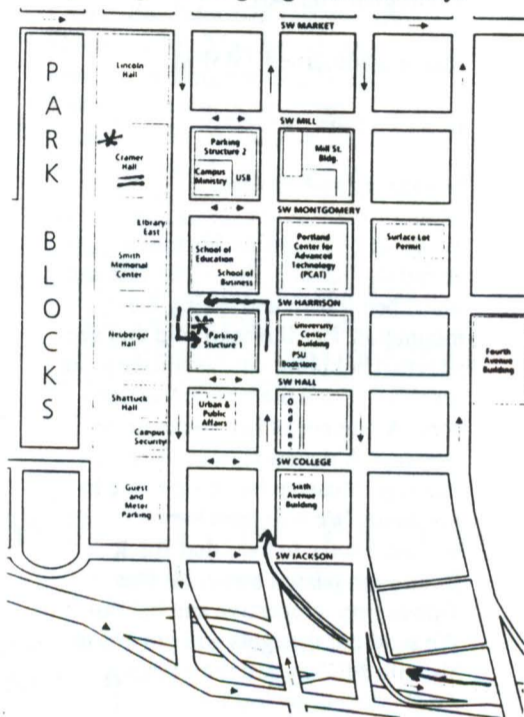
3:00 Walking parade (45 min)

March 15, 1998
