BRIEF HISTORICAL SKETCH OF THE PACIFIC COAST NORWEGIAN SINGERS' ASSOCIATION

Vocal utterance in song has always been among the most significant factors in the progress and development of human relationships. History proves that music, through the songs of a people, has had its highest cultivation and development among freedom-loving and progressive nations. It is only natural that Norway should have a musical culture that is among the oldest and richest in the world. From the days of the Vikings, to our present time, singing has been considered a national heritage of the Norwegian people. Virtually every community in Norway has its singing societies, and A Cappella male chorus singing has gained an important place in the musical life of the nation. Great Sangerfests are held as a result of choruses joining into associations throughout the country in which as many as five to six thousand men participate.

Immortal composers like Greig, Sinding, Svendsen, Ole Olsen, Kjerulf and numerous others have given us male chorus compositions of lasting beauty, compositions that rightfully belong among the finest the world has produced in this form of music.

Due to such traditions and musical environment, the Norwegian people have cultivated a fine sense of appreciation of good

music. This heritage they have carried with them to America and here in the land of their choice they have contributed vitally and gloriously to America's great musical progress. Wherever Norwegians have colonized in the United States, Norwegian male choruses are to be found, and on the Pacific Coast many have been in existence since pioneer times.

Sponsored by enthusiastic supporters, the idea of forming an association of all the choruses on the Pacific Coast, for the purpose of joining in annual song festivals, took form in 1902, with Mr. F. A. Tomte of Portland, Oregon, being instrumental in arranging a meeting of representatives of various choruses in Seattle, Washington. At this meeting the Pacific Coast Norwegian Singers Association was founded. The first Sangerfest was held in Everett, Washington, in 1903. Since then, Sangerfests have been held and celebrated in the principal cities of the Pacific Coast.

The Norwegian Male Chorus extends a hearty welcome to all Singers and friends attending this, the Thirty-Ninth Convention of the Association, and the first Sangerfest to be held in Los Angeles.

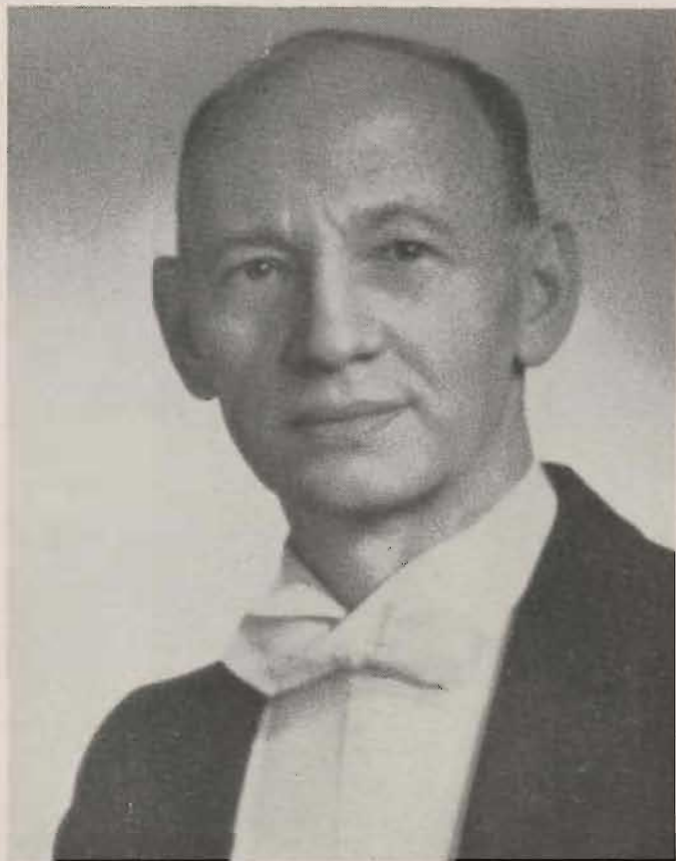

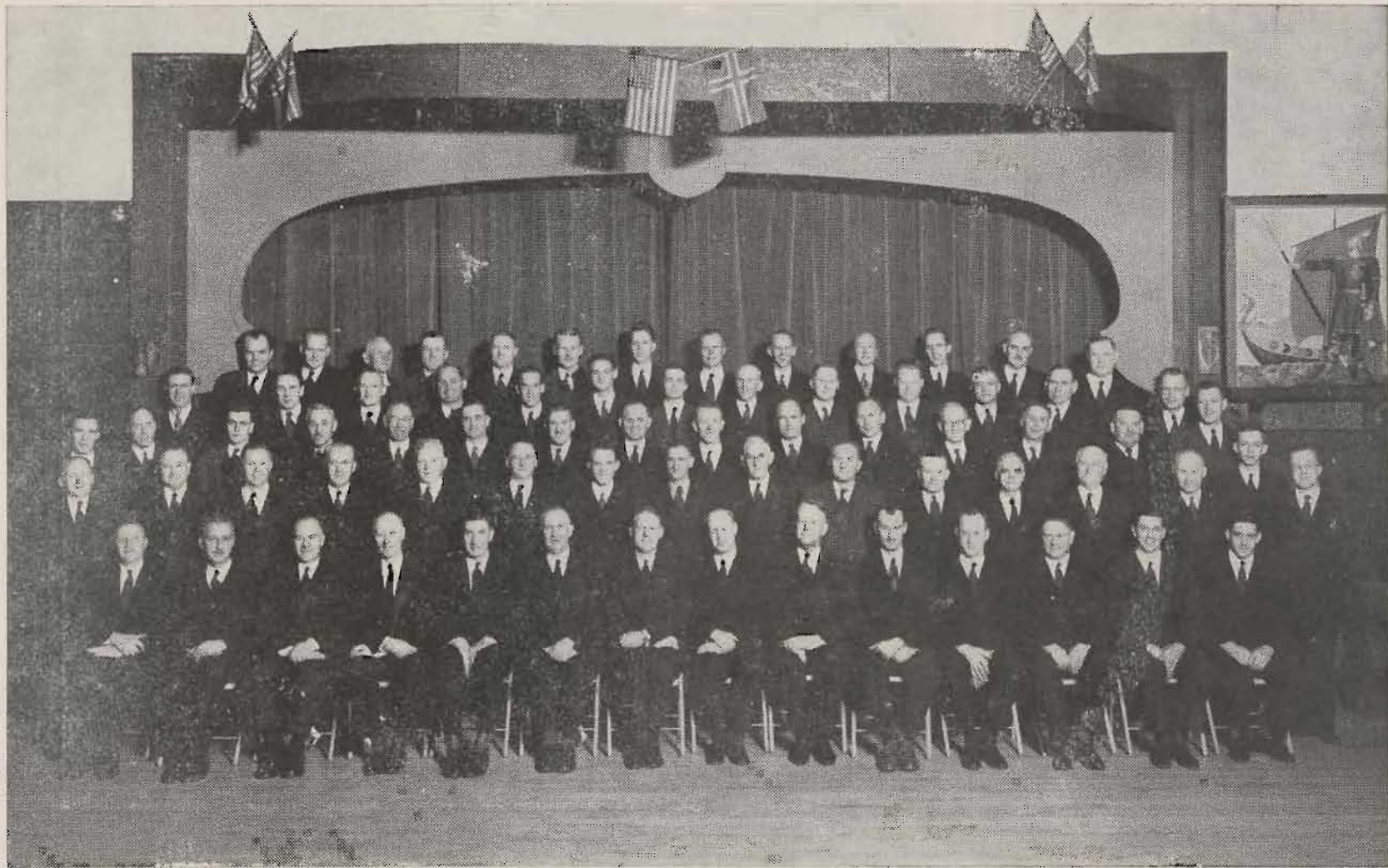

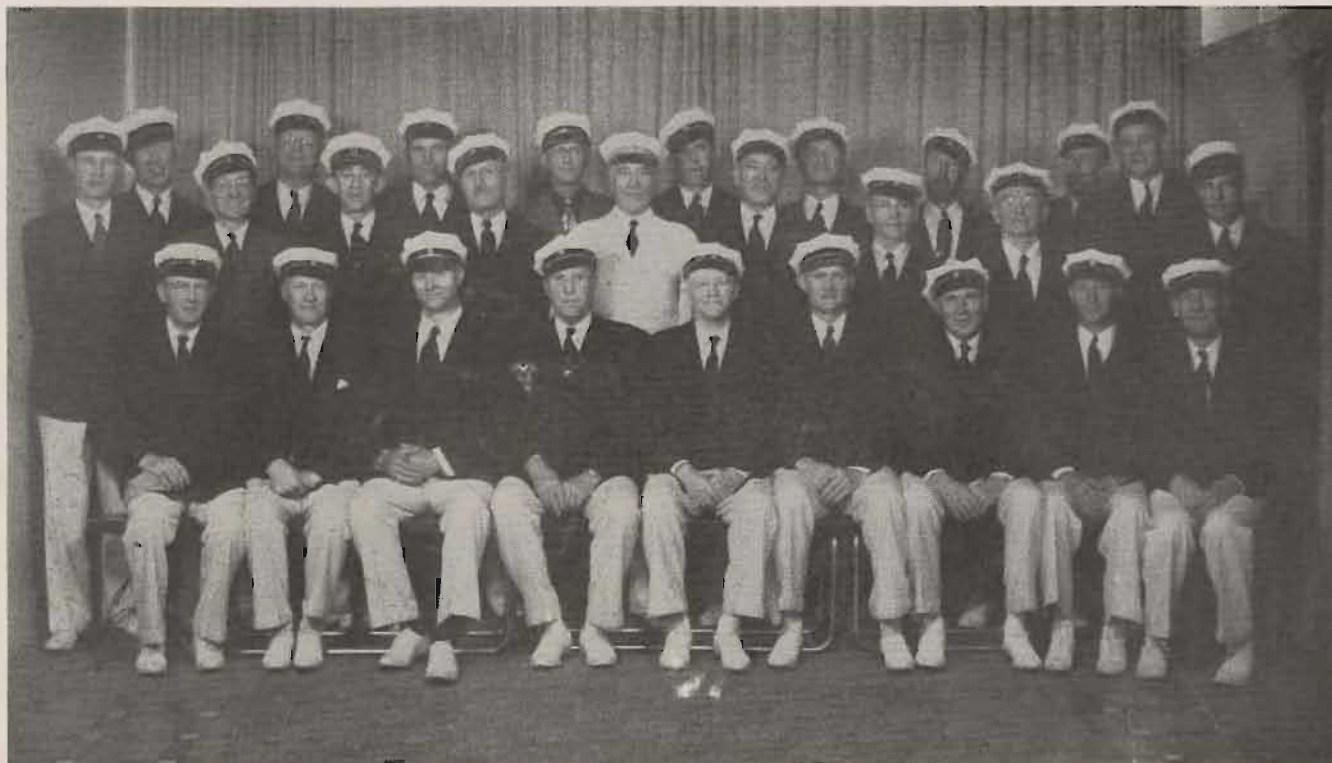
