## Boy Scouts Plan Pancake Supper

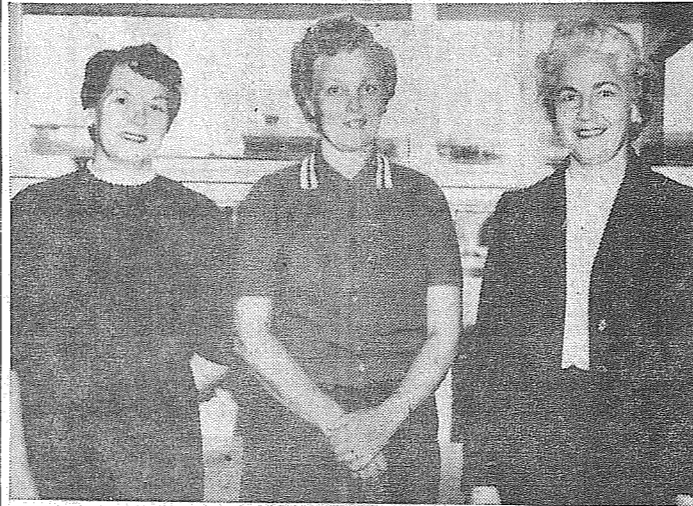

Election of officers for the coming year will be held Nov. 10. The birthday dinner celebrating the 31st anniversary of Benston Grange will be held Nov. 24.

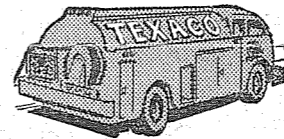

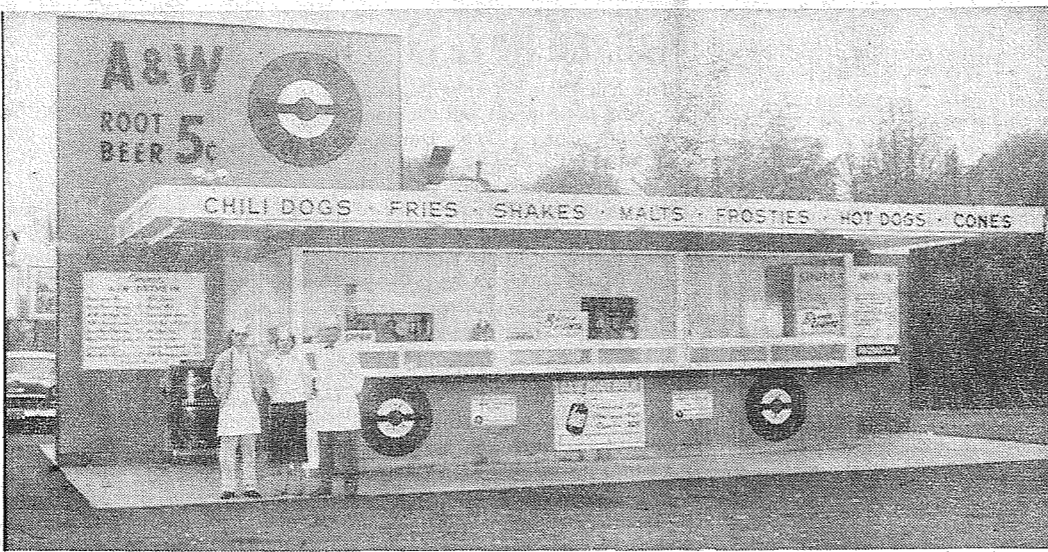

**a-Wondering . . .**  
**and a-Wandering . . .**

Editor Floyd Shaylor of the Plain City, Ohio, Advocate, has something important to say about newspapers: "A strong editorial policy is the best indication of a good newspaper. It matters not whether an individual agrees with what a newspaper says editorially—it does matter a great deal as to whether the reader, through the medium of the editorial, gives consideration and thought to the subject at hand. If he strongly opposes a newspaper's opinion, it is all for the best since it indicates that he has read and considered the subject and has found it to be contrary to his own beliefs . . . We will never complain because we have accomplished our real purpose—that of causing you to read what we have to say!" If Floyd's theory is correct then I've sure been doing a bang up job of stirring up interest, judging by the number of people who have gone out of their way to let me know they think I've slipped my trolley.

The State of Oregon has long used yellow dividing lines on its highways. The evidence indicates that most motorists feel that they provided much better visibility than white lines, particularly in bad weather, and so are an important safety factor.

But now Oregon's Highway Dept. announces that white lines will replace the yellow. Reason: The Federal government dictates that states must adopt white lines—or lose their share of the funds allocated to the multi-billion dollar interstate highway system.

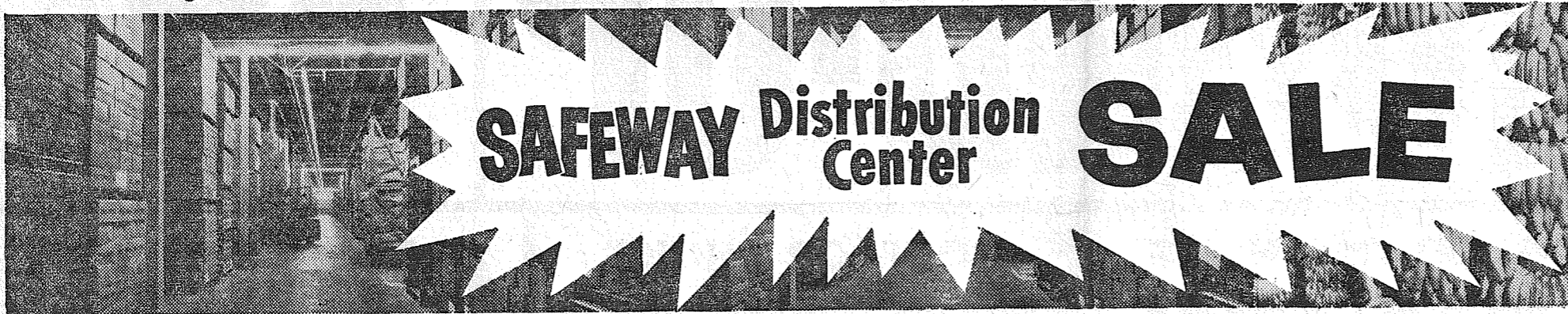
The significance of this goes far beyond any merits and demerits of white-lines-vs.-yellow-lines. The Portland Oregonian makes the big point with admirable clarity: "When one accepts a 'gift' from Washington, one gives up the free choice that states, as well as individuals, hold dear. When Uncle Sam puts up the money for a new suit, he not only decides what kind of suit it shall be but also picks the color of the tie."

This should surprise no one—the principle is as old as government. Centuries ago, someone remarked that "he who pays the piper calls the tune." Now a swollen central government pays more and more pipers, and calls more and more of our tunes.

It seems to me that the more problems we solve for ourselves on the local level, the better off we'll all be. Too many people now-a-days would rather stand the tune then put forth the needed effort to forestall the cost of a piper playing under someone else's direction. We're fast becoming a nation of so-whatters.

Somebody's nuttier than a fruit cake and I still feel fine so I vote that the next likely person is the joker who laid out some of the interchanges on our new freeway. Have you ever tried getting onto the freeway, when approaching on 109th street? Now there's a real marvel of safety through engineering. As you go up onto the overpass a row of buttons pilots you into the inside lane thus allowing cars to come sweeping up beside you in the outside lane from the freeway below. To get down onto the freeway yourself you must do a hard right turn across the flow of this outside lane traffic. You have two choices on how to accomplish this. You can stop to let this outside lane traffic flow by while some character pushes your back seat up around your neck or you can turn right and let someone else drive through your right front door. This is an excellent way to meet people but I'm afraid it will never become popular. Of course there is always the chance that you can get through this mess while there is no other traffic and in that case you may live to drive on the freeway below.
