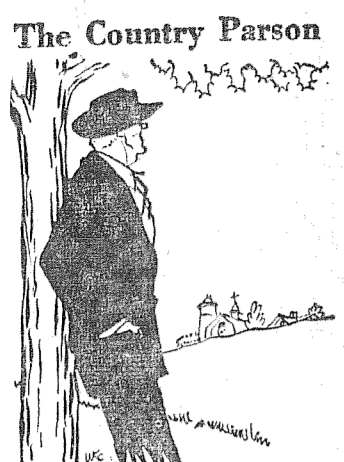

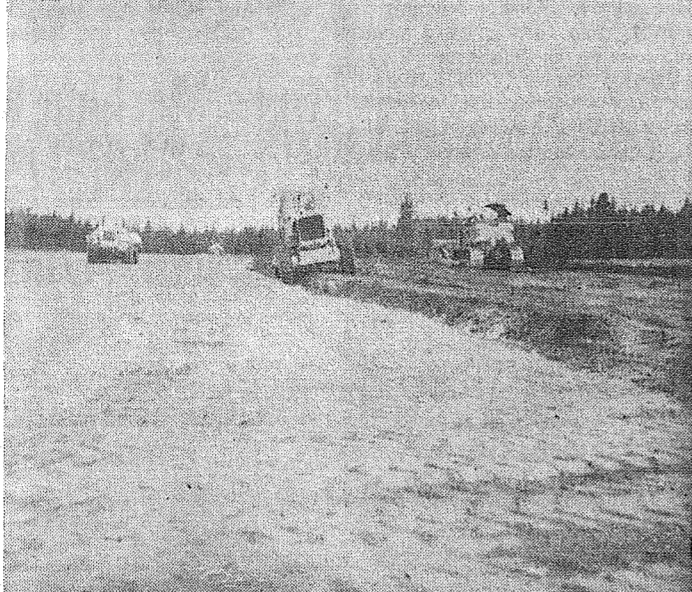

## New Drag Track Near Thun Field Schedules Opening for Early April



**DRAG STRIP**—Graders, earth movers and other pieces of heavy construction equipment (shown above) are being used to clear eighty acres of land adjacent to Thun Field. The cleared area will be turned into a drag racing track by Drag Corporation. The new track is scheduled to open in early April.

When completed the track will offer drag enthusiasts a 3200 by 60 foot asphalt strip on which to test their cars. Races held on the track will be under the supervision of the Puyallup Valley Racing Association, according to Rogers.

Entrance to the track will be off Mitchell Gould Road. A parking area for about 5,000 cars will be available at the track.

Rogers said the strip will be opened to the public when races are scheduled. No firm race schedule has been established, however. Plans for the track were drawn up after Rogers' two sons sold him on the idea of developing an area where drag racers could test their cars under safe conditions.

Rogers added that he hoped the opening of the track would help eliminate drag races on the highways.

## Local Man in Military Exercises

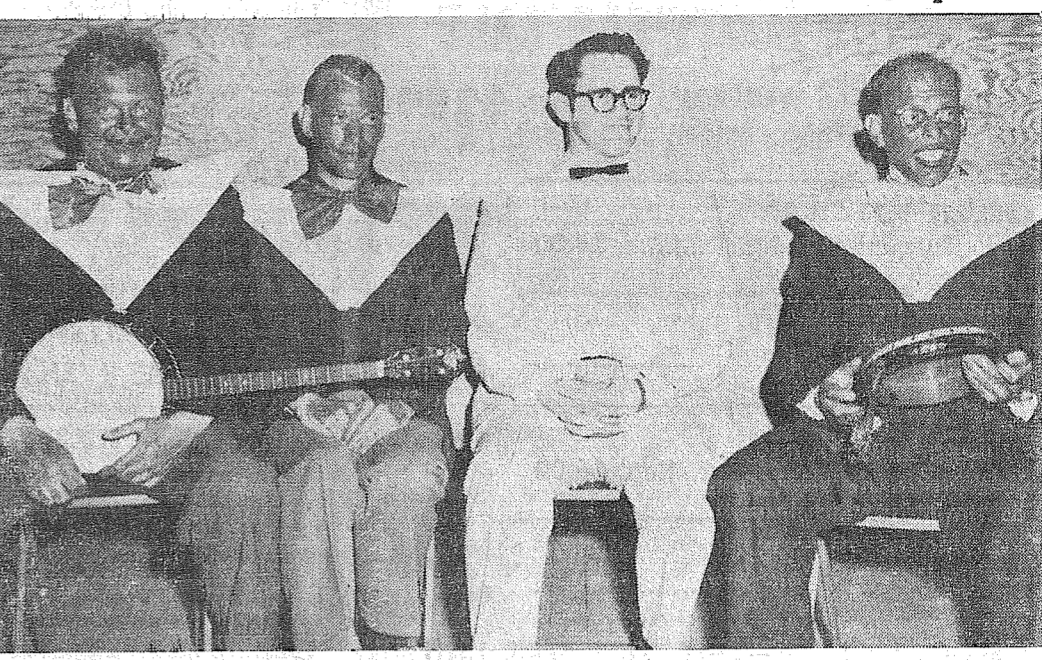

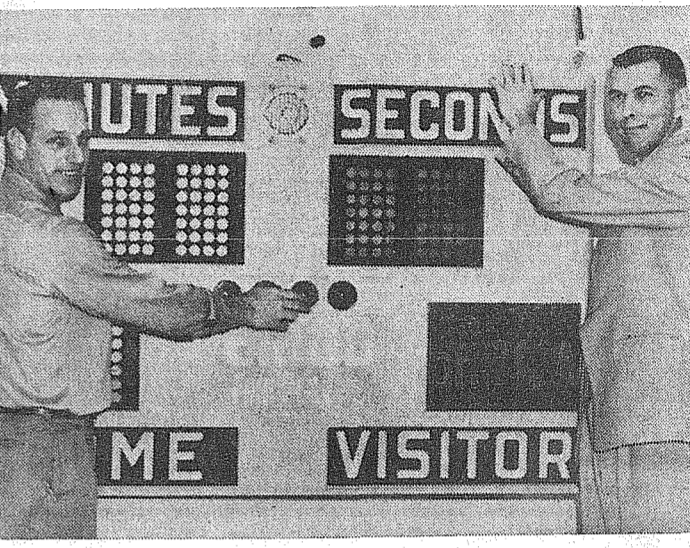

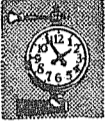

**a-Wondering . . .  
and a-Wandering . . .**  
With JACK BROWN

This week I have been wandering down Puerto Rico way with the Military Air Transport Service. As I sit here in the press center at Ramey AFB, I have no way of knowing how much you have seen or heard about the Big Slam Puerto Pine maneuvers. Right now the world's largest peace time airlift is in full swing and will still be as you read these words. In the air overhead is the constant sound of planes and choppers. In the not too distant mountains, guns are belching flame and sending their missiles crashing into the jungles of Puerto Rico.

Perhaps you have read all you care to about all this for the wires from this center have been kept hot constantly. Hundreds of pounds of film has been airmailed back to the states, cameras are grinding away for the TV stations, newsmen are snapping shots by the thousands and the chatter of typewriters here in the press center is almost deafening, yet I would like to give you my impressions of this airlift for I feel that perhaps I may have a clearer insight as to what may be in your mind regarding a maneuver of this sort for I believe there exists a closer relationship between readers and the personnel of weeklies than is the case in any other medium.

I could take the easy way out and grab up any one of the dozens of canned stories released to us by the military PIO officers but I think I prefer to strike out on my own and try to give you my thinking on the subject.

Living as we do in Pierce County near two large military installations, we are perhaps more apt to become hardened and immune to watching, thinking about, or trying to analyze the purpose of a military maneuver than others throughout the nation.

To me this maneuver has more significance than any other I've read about, seen or heard of for in this one the entire nation, civilian and military, stand to find the answer to one big question! Could the United States ever be caught again with its defenses at half mast? After spending four days here watching and observing I say there will never again be land under the American flag waiting and watching in time of war for supplies and supporting troops that never arrive. MATS can do the job and though there are those who will argue with me over the merits of this military operation versus civilian, I can say without fear of contradiction that no civilian organization could begin to spring into action on any such scale, now or any time in the near future.

I've stood here and watched these giant MATS planes land eight to the hour, unload and be serviced in one and a half hours, ready for the return flight. I personally flew down here in a C-133 loaded with thirty tons of equipment and troops. I was one of the first ones out the passenger hatch after landing, yet I could not catch a picture of the first piece of equipment to be unloaded. The first one was rolling on the ground before the plane's engines had been stopped.

I have seen the National Guard, Navy, Marine Corps, Army and Air Force in action at a wartime tempo, working side by side with the highest spirit of co-operation I have ever had the pleasure of witnessing.

No one here can pinpoint the origin of this voluntary step up in tempo of personnel movement and accomplishments. Military officers are standing around here watching in amazement as record after record is broken. A "can do" spirit exists such as none dared dream of. It has swept the entire operation from origination points in the States to the firing line in the hills of Puerto Rico.

Like all Americans everywhere, I await the day when the efforts and expense of an airlift such as this can be converted into producing material things for a peace time world. In the interim I will say this: God help those who dare an attempt to despoil the flag of the United States of America!
