GENERAL INFORMATION

ADMISSION -- Students desiring academic courses leading to a degree or certification must meet the General University Requirements for admission or must present evidence of being prepared for college work. Transcripts or a letter of good standing may be required.

COURSE SYSTEM -- Pacific Lutheran University has adopted the course system and the 4-1-4 calendar beginning with the Fall 1969 semester. The academic year is divided into a 14-week Semester, a 4-week Interim, and a second 14-week Semester. One course equals 4 semester hours.

REGISTRATION -- Part-time students may register during January from 10:30 a. m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays or on the first evening the class meets. The Registrar's Office will be open from 6-8:00 p.m. Thursday, February 4, and Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday February 8, 9, and 10 to accomodate evening students. Classes begin Thursday February 4..

CHANGE IN REGISTRATION -- All changes in registration must be officially made in the Registrar's Office and completed in the Business Office. The change of registration fee is \$5.00 An unofficial withdrawal from a course will be regarded as a failure.

COURSE NUMBERING -- Courses open to freshmen and sophomores are numbered 101-299 and are considered lower division subjects. Courses open to juniors and seniors are numbered 300-400 or above and are regarded as upper division subjects. Courses numbered 500 are open to graduate students only.

TUITION -- Tuition for late afternoon and evening courses is \$232.00 per course (\$58.00 per semester hour).
