CLASS SCHEDULE (Preliminary) FALL SEMESTER, 1966

The 1966 Fall semester offerings are listed alphabetically according to departments.

The number in parenthesis following the course title is the number of semester hours of credit allowed for the course. Courses open to freshmen and sophomores are numbered 101-299 and are considered lower division subjects. Courses open to juniors and seniors are numbered 300-499 and are regarded as upper division subjects. Courses numbered 500 are open to graduate students only.

Lower division students may take upper division courses and have them apply toward the 48 hour requirement, however, normally this opportunity would be quite limited since, in any case, prerequisites will have to be met. Prerequisites can be ascertained from your adviser or the general catalog. In most cases lower division courses are basic and should be completed before registering for upper division courses.

A student must have a grade point average of 2.25 to be eligible to register for any courses in the School of Education, with the exception of Education 202.

The letters La, Lb, Lc, etc., refer to the laboratory sections. The letter S with a number (S1, S2, etc.) refers to class sections, a Q refers to Quiz sections.

The time for the courses is given according to periods in the day and not according to the hour of the day. The student's program should designate the period and not the hour of the day except in cases where the time is clearly indicated on the schedule as for late afternoon and evening classes.

The University reserves the right to cancel any class for justifiable cause.

Registration Procedures

1. Make application for re-entry and pay tuition deposit in Business Office.
2. Make an appointment with your adviser.
3. Pick up registration material in the registrar's office. (You will receive a tentative schedule worksheet at this time. Official registration forms will be completed in the fall, according to an assigned time schedule which will give priority to students who pre-registered in the spring.)
4. Complete the worksheet with your adviser's approval, and turn it in at the registrar's office.
5. Filling in final forms, Student Personnel, and Business Office will take place September 17-18, 1966.
