FALL SCHEDULE — 1961

The 1961 Fall semester offerings are listed alphabetically according to departments.

Courses open to freshmen and sophomores are numbered 101-299 and are considered lower division subjects. Courses open to juniors and seniors are numbered 300-499 and are regarded as upper division subjects. Courses numbered 500 are open to graduate students only.

The student should have his entire program made up of subjects in the division in which he classifies.

Prerequisites can be ascertained from your adviser or the general catalog. In most cases lower division courses are basic and should be completed before registering for upper division courses.

A student must have a grade point average of 2.25 to be eligible to register for any courses in the School of Education.

The number in parentheses following the course title is the number of semester hours of credit allowed for the course.

The letters La, Lb, Lc, etc., refer to the laboratory sections. The letter S with a number (S1, S2, etc.) refers to class section.

The time for the courses is given according to periods in the day and not according to the hour of the day. The student's program should designate the period and not the hour of the day except in cases where the time is clearly indicated on the schedule as for late afternoon and evening classes.

The University reserves the right to cancel any class for justifiable cause.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Former Students and Transfers

Monday and to noon Tuesday, September 18, 19

1. Obtain your registration card in room A-105. (Former students who have pre-registered get your cards in A-102, then go to A-111.)
2. Confer with your adviser. Advisers will be in their offices. If you do not have an appointment, go to the Registrar's Office to arrange an appointment.
3. Go to the lobby of the Administration Building to get class cards and have your schedule checked.
4. Report to the Assistant Dean of Students room A-111.
5. Fill out your class cards in room A-117.
6. Pay fees at the Business Office, room A-110.

Freshmen

Tuesday afternoon and Wednesday, Sept. 19, 21

1. Pick up your registration cards in room A-105, and then go to meet your adviser according to the scheduled appointment designated in the letter previously sent to your home address. (Freshmen who have pre-registered: After the brief meeting with your adviser go directly to the Assistant Dean of Students, A-111.)
2. Freshmen who have not pre-registered: Go to the lobby of the Administration Building to have schedules checked and to get class cards.
3. Report to the Assistant Dean of Students, A 111.
4. Fill out class cards in A-117.
5. Pay fees in the Business Office, A-110.

No registration is complete until it has been cleared through the Business Office.
