AUDIT COURSES CHARGED AT CREDIT RATE

FULL-TIME STUDENTS WHO DO NOT EXCEED 35 HOURS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR MAY NEED
AN ADJUSTMENT TO REDUCE THE TUITION TOTAL TO THE \$7760.00 MAXIMUM FOR THE
YEAR. THIS ADJUSTMENT IS CALLED THE CCP SPRING DISCOUNT AND IS APPLIED AT
THE SPRING SEMESTER BILLING. STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN A STUDY ABROAD
PROGRAM DURING THE ACADEMIC YEAR ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE CCP SPRING
DISCOUNT.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

1. PAYMENT BY SEMESTER -- IF THIS OPTION IS SELECTED, THE TOTAL COST OF EACH
SEMESTER MUST BE PAID BEFORE CLASSES BEGIN. THE UNIVERSITY WILL ACCEPT
VISA AND MASTERCARD BANK CARDS. INDICATE CARD TYPE, ACCOUNT NUMBER, AND
EXPIRATION DATE.
2. PLU BUDGET PLAN -- THE PLU BUDGET PLAN IS A CONVENIENT, NO INTEREST,
MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN. THE COST OF THE ENTIRE YEAR IS ESTIMATED NOW
AND PAID OVER TWELVE (12) MONTHS, BEGINNING MAY 10TH AND ENDING APRIL
10TH. FOR THOSE STUDENTS WHO WILL BE HERE FALL TERM ONLY, PAYMENTS BEGIN
MAY 10TH AND END OCTOBER 10TH. FOR THOSE WHO WILL BE HERE SPRING TERM
ONLY, PAYMENTS BEGIN NOVEMBER 10TH AND END APRIL 10TH. THERE IS A 2%
LATE CHARGE FOR PAYMENTS RECEIVED AFTER THE 15TH OF EACH MONTH AND BUDGET
PLAN APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THE FIRST PAYMENT DATE (MAY 10TH OR
NOVEMBER 10TH) ARE CHARGED A 2% LATE CHARGE AND ALSO PAY THE BACK
PAYMENTS AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION. CONTACT THE BUSINESS OFFICE FOR
FURTHER INFORMATION.
3. SEMESTER INSTALLMENT PLAN -- THE SEMESTER INSTALLMENT PLAN REQUIRES A 25%
MINIMUM DOWN PAYMENT AND THERE IS A FINANCE CHARGE. THE BALANCE
REMAINING (PLU FINANCE CHARGE) IS DIVIDED INTO THREE (3) MONTHLY
PAYMENTS, DUE BY THE 15TH OF THE MONTH (E.G., FALL -- OCTOBER 15,
NOVEMBER 15, DECEMBER 15; AND SPRING -- MARCH 15, APRIL 15, MAY 15).
IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR THIS PLAN, ALL PRIOR BALANCES WITH PLU MUST BE
PAID IN FULL. APPLICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PLAN SHOULD BE MADE
BY THE 10TH DAY OF THE SEMESTER, AND THE 25% MINIMUM DOWN PAYMENT IS
REQUIRED WITH THE APPLICATION. CONTACT THE BUSINESS OFFICE FOR FURTHER
INFORMATION.

UNPAID BALANCES ARE SUBJECT TO LATE CHARGES IF NOT PAID BY PUBLISHED

IF A CLASS REQUIRES THE USE OF A COMPUTER, THE INSTRUCTOR MAY OBTAIN ACCOUNTS FOR THE CLASS. CHECK WITH THE INSTRUCTOR BEFORE REQUESTING AN INDIVIDUAL ACCOUNT. ANY STUDENT MAY OBTAIN AN ACCOUNT FOR THE VAX SYSTEM AT THE COMPUTER CENTER OFFICES BETWEEN 8:00 AM AND 5:00 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY. TO USE THE PERSONAL COMPUTERS, PRESENT A VALID ID CARD AT EITHER OF THE USER ROOMS. USE OF THE FACILITIES ARE RESTRICTED TO CURRENTLY ENROLLED STUDENTS.

REFUND POLICY

IF YOU DROP A SINGLE CLASS OR COMPLETELY WITHDRAW FROM THE TERM DURING THE FIRST TWO WEEKS OF THE FALL OR SPRING SEMESTER, A FULL TUITION REFUND WILL BE GIVEN. THE ADVANCE PAYMENT IS NOT REFUNDED. A TEN PERCENT PER DAY CHARGE WILL BE ASSESSED FOR COMPLETE WITHDRAWALS DURING THE THIRD AND FOURTH WEEK. NO REFUNDS ARE AVAILABLE AFTER THE FOURTH WEEK FOR COMPLETE WITHDRAWALS, OR AFTER THE SECOND WEEK OF THE TERM FOR DROPPING INDIVIDUAL COURSES.

ENGLISH

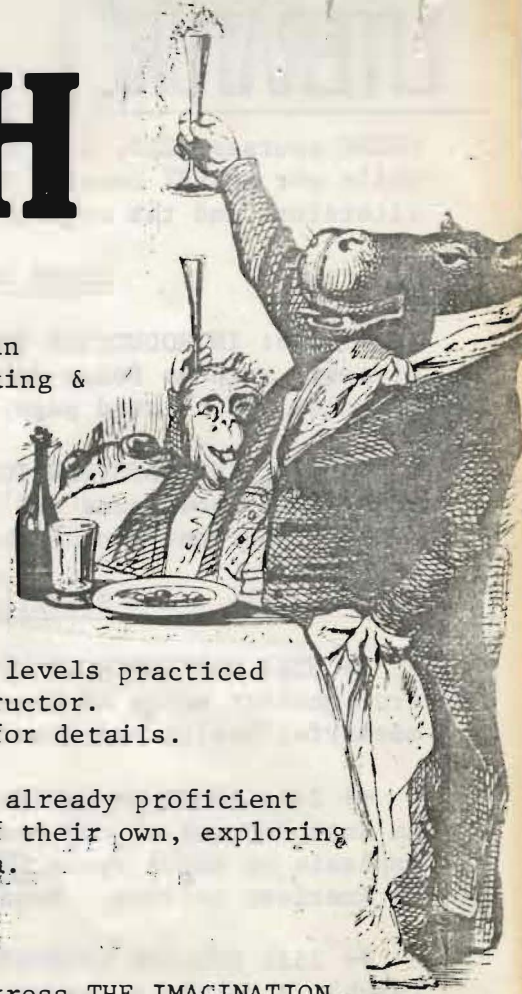
WRITING

Three lower division courses meet the GUR in writing: 101, 201, 225. So does Philosophy 121: Critical Thinking & Writing. Advanced students may use English 324 or 328.

++ 101: COLLEGE ENGLISH (12 sections) Emphasizes college-level skills in reading and writing, including the discovery of topics, development of ideas, and revision for clarity, substance, and voice. See the instructor for more detail.

++ 201: INTERMEDIATE WRITING (Marvin Lansverk) For those who want to extend their skills in expository prose beyond the levels practiced in 101. Prerequisite: 101, AP English, or consent of the instructor.
NOTE: Rick Jones will teach 201 this Interim. Check with him for details.

++ 225: AUTOBIOGRAPHICAL WRITING (Chuck Bergman) Students already proficient at the 101 level read life stories of others and write parts of their own, exploring how styles of self complement styles of writing, and vice versa.



* * * * * This spring we offer a strong set of courses that stress THE IMAGINATION. These courses (227, 327, 366) do not meet the GUR in writing.

++227: IMAGINATIVE WRITING (Rick Jones) Explores what imaginative writing, especially poetry but short fiction too, is all about from the writer's point of view: a course for adventurous beginners.

++ 327: IMAGINATIVE WRITING (Noëlle de Chambrun) Our fourth Distinguished Writer in Residence, a visitor from the University of Paris, will help students who already have some experience writing stories or poetry extend their horizons. Mme de Chambrun's own speciality is short fiction, often for children, that explores the contemporary relevance of old myths. Tally cards are available in the English department, HA 200.

++ 366: WRITING FOR CHILDREN (Suzanne Rahn) A workshop in writing for children and teenagers that experiments with a variety of forms--fantasy, realism, nonfiction, picture-books. Also an introduction to contemporary children's literature.

* * * * * The following advanced courses stress non-fiction prose. The last two (324, 328) meet the GUR in writing,; 322 does not though it may be taken for major, minor, or elective credit.

++ 322: PUBLISHING PROCEDURES (Megan Benton) Though part of the "Publishing and Printing Arts Program," this course may be taken by itself. It follows the life-cycle of a book, from initial idea to final marketing, with some emphasis on editorial techniques.

++ 324: FREELANCE WRITING (Chuck Bergman) A workshop course, in which you learn to write for publications; includes analyzing markets, writing queries, doing research, revising up to professional standards, and finally submitting manuscripts.

++ 328: ADVANCED COMPOSITION (Richard Jenseth) A workshop in a variety of forms, from personal essays to academic articles, with serious fussing over sentences and paragraphs for clarity and style. Required for certification to teach high school English, but valuable to all advanced students who want to polish their prose.

LITERATURE

We offer two kinds of introductory literature courses: our GENRE courses (216, 217) emphasize how to read a literary text in appropriate ways, while our SURVEY courses (231, 241, 252) stress literary history and the links between literature and the society out of which it emerges.

GENRE COURSES: 216, 217

++ 216: INTRODUCTION TO POETRY (Rick Jones) An exploration of how poetry works: elements such as image and meter, forms from the sonnet to free verse, the relation of voice and printed page, finding meaning in mood as well as idea.

++ 217: INTRODUCTION TO FICTION (David Seal) Reading short stories and short novels to discover how scene and character, image and plot, create miniature worlds that reveal important truths about our big world and those of us who live in it.

SURVEY COURSES: 231, 241, 252

++ 231: MASTERPIECES OF EUROPEAN LITERATURE (Marvin Lansverk) A study of classics from ancient epics of Greece and Rome, through medieval romance and realism, to the masterful poetry and drama of Renaissance Italy, France, and England.

++ 241: AMERICAN LITERATURE (Section A: Gloria Martin. Section B: Dennis Martin) An introduction to our own tradition, from colonial times to the 20th century, with emphasis on major texts (The Scarlet Letter, Moby-Dick, Huck Finn) and their relation to American culture. Required for English majors.

++ 252: ENGLISH LITERATURE: AFTER 1750 (Section A: Greg Johnson. Section B: Nancy Leigh) A survey of poetry and fiction from the breakup of the "reasonable" world of the 18th century to our modern world of uncertainty, emphasizing major authors such as Wordsworth and Virginia Woolf. Required for English majors.

* * * * * Our UPPER DIVISION LITERATURE COURSES are designed both for English majors and for others who want the challenge of more sophisticated analysis and more extensive reading and writing assignments. All these meet the GUR in literature.

HISTORICAL PERIOD COURSES emphasize literary and cultural history.

++ 333: 20TH-CENTURY AMERICAN FICTION & DRAMA (Paul Benton) A study of major novelists (Faulkner, Hemingway) and dramatists (O'Neill, Williams) of the Jazz Age, the Depression, and the world of fascism, communism, and atom splitting.

++ 384: ENGLISH RENAISSANCE LITERATURE (Chuck Bergman) Explores the creative explosion in English drama from the exuberant language of Kyd and Marlowe, through the glorious 1590s (Shakespeare, Jonson, Dekker), to the dark and anxious plays of Webster, Ford, and Middleton.

MAJOR AUTHOR COURSES include critical approaches and library research.

++ 382: CHAUCER (Suzanne Rahn) The Canterbury Tales and other major works of the late Middle Ages, one of the great periods of English poetry. Includes an introduction to Middle English and to the traditions of romance, satire, and allegory Chaucer used.

++ 452: SEMINAR--D. H. LAWRENCE (Tom Campbell) A study of a great and controversial novelist of our century, who explored the mystery of instinctual drives and human relations both in the industrialized world of modern England and the primitive world of Mexican Indians.

SPECIAL COURSES: 345 & 364 meet the GUR in literature; 331 does not.

++ 345: CANADIAN FICTION (Lucille Johnson) Stories and novels of immigrants, of realists and romantics, of women and (especially) native peoples. First or last half may be taken alone for 2 hours credit.

++ 364: LEWIS CARROLL (Noëlle de Chambrun) Our Distinguished Writer from Paris explores the wonderfully queer worlds of Alice in Wonderland and of Alice's creator.

++ 331: ART OF THE BOOK (Megan Benton) A 2-credit studio course in book design, typography, paper, binding, and especially the art of letterpress printing. Students who have completed 331 may continue independent projects in 332. Major, minor, and elective credit, but not GUR.
