

GENERAL REGISTRATION DIRECTIONS

PLEASE INDICATE THE SYSTEM CODE NUMBER FOR EACH COURSE REGISTRATION.

- All students currently in school who plan to register for the following semester (summer excepted) should register by Advance Registration. Note: Interim and Spring registrations are combined and conducted simultaneously.
- Full-time new and re-entry students may advance register if a clearance has been received from admissions. Part-time students are encouraged to advance register.

3. SELECTIVE SERVICE-ATTENTION ALL MALE STUDENTS

If you want your local draft board notified of your full-time enrollment (2½ courses) at P.L.U., it is your responsibility to complete a form in the Registrar's Office. This is normally done only once a year.

4. V.A. BENEFITS

If you expect to receive any type of veteran or war orphan benefits, you must file your certificate of eligibility in the Registrar's Office. Forms and information concerning veteran benefits are available in the Registrar's Office. Make application when registering. A student must be registered for 3 courses to be eligible for full-time V.A. Benefits.

- 5. Obtain your registration materials at the Registrar's Office.
- 6. Ob ain an appointment with your adviser, DO THIS IMMEDIATELY.
- 7. Print with a BLACK LEAD PENCIL on your official program.
 - A, Fill in all personal information including your Social Security Number. If you do not have a Social Security Number, you must secure one prior to registering.
 - B. Indicate SYSTEM CODE NUMBER for each course registration.
 - C. Print an "A" before audit courses, "R" before repeat courses.
 - D. Check to be certain that you have the pre-requisites, as indicated in the University Catalog, for each course you select.
 - E. LIST ALTERNATE COURSES which can be substituted if courses on your original schedule are closed. The listing of alternate courses may prevent a change of registration later.
 - F. Obtain the signature of your adviser if you are a full-time (2½ courses) student,

ADVANCE REGISTRATION ONLY

- A. Leave your registration materials in the Registrar's Office.
- B. Advance registration will be processed by class in the order they are received with seniors first, then juniors, sophomores, and freshmen. Every effort is made to comply with your requests. If a course is closed, an approved alternate will be substituted. Note: Seniors will receive priority in interim courses for the first week of registration only.
- C. You will be mailed a statement of charges including the fee payment deadline, a copy of your scheduled classes, additional instructions, and cards.
- D. Return your payment and the other information requested to the P.L.U. Business Office by the due date indicated.

IN PERSON REGISTRATION

- A. Obtain the necessary cards at the Registrar's Office.
- B. Complete all cards, Obtain adviser's approval if full-time (see "F" above).
- C. Report to the Registrar's Office to be scheduled.
- D. As soon as you are scheduled and receive a copy of your program, report to the Business Office to pay your fees.

INDEPENDENT STUDY REGISTRATION

A special independent study registration card must be submitted to the Registrar's Office with each independent study registration. These cards may be obtained at the Registrar's Office.

PASS-FAIL OPTION for UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

A Pass—Fail Agreement form is available to all undergraduate students desiring a course on the pass—fail option. Secure the form from the Registrar's Office.

CHANGE OF REGISTRATION, WITHDRAWALS

Any addition or withdrawal from a course must be made in the Registrar's Office. Changes in registration due to conflicts or errors in registration may be made without charge during the first week of the semester. To withdraw from a class and/or add a class, the following procedure is to be followed:

- 1. Obtain the change of registration form from the Registrar's Office.
- 2. Obtain the necessary signature and, if applicable, a withdrawal grade.
- 3. If after the first week, pay the \$5.00 change of registration fee at the Business Office.
- 4. Return the change of registration form to the Registrar.

The student is responsible for completing the above steps within one week after obtaining the change card.

Students withdrawing officially from a class after the fourth week of a semester will receive either a WP (withdrawal with passing), a WF (withdrawal with failure), or a WM (Medical Withdrawal). None of these grades will be used in calculating grade point average, but they will appear on the semester grade point report and be included in review of academic status. The grade of W will replace WP, WF, and WM on the transcript.

STUDENT MOTOR VEHICLE REGULATIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Each student must complete a vehicle registration card, whether or not he is registering a vehicle.

The University suggests to all students that there is normally no requirement for on-campus students to maintain private vehicles while in attendance at Pacific Lutheran University. However, in case you are working or living off campus or if there is other special need for a vehicle, strict compliance with the following regulations will be enforced.

REGISTRATION OF VEHICLES:

All students who bring cars or other motorized vehicles to the campus must register them with the Security Office. Any unregistered vehicle on campus property is subject to "tow away"; the tow away fee is payable by the owner of the vehicle.

Decal will be good from September to September.

DECALS:

Pick up your decal at the Security Office. Temporary decals may be acquired in the Security Office for replacement vehicles, loaners, etc., without charge. During registration week there will be a period of grace so students will have proper time to register vehicles. This is done in order to save embarrassment or loss of revenue to the student.

CAMPUS PARKING AREAS:

For students who are not using their vehicles daily it is desired that full use be made of the lots available on lower campus so that commuters may make use of the parking spaces available on upper campus. In the past, residents of 121st Street between Park Avenue and "I" Street have complained because their driveways and mail boxes were blocked. In order to maintain good community relations, we must employ all means available to prevent hardships and inconveniences to our neighbors. If there are any questions, feel free to call Security, extension 247, at any time.

Certain courses contain a lecture, a lab., a discussion session, or various combinations of the three. Registration for these courses are usually processed by lab. or discussion section.

The System Code Number will determined how it is processed. Indicate the SCN for the lab. or discussion section desired.

ATTENDANCE IS REQUIRED IN ALL PORTIONS OF THE COURSE.

THIS CLASS SCHEDULE INDICATES WHICH HOURS AND ROOMS HAVE BEEN RESERVED FOR MEETINGS OF INDIVIDUAL CLASSES. THE MEETINGS WILL TYPICALLY BE CONFINED TO THE TIMES AND PLACES INDICATED, BUT IN KEEPING WITH ANNOUNCED FLEXIBILITY AND INDIVIDUALITY IN THE CONDUCT OF STUDIES AT THE UNIVERSITY, THE NUMBER OF POSSIBLE CLASS MEETINGS UTILIZED PER WEEK MAY VARY FROM COURSE TO COURSE, OR FROM WEEK TO WEEK WITHIN ANY ONE COURSE. WHERE FORMAL CONTACT HOURS ARE REDUCED, IT IS EXPECTED THAT THE INSTRUCTOR WILL PROVIDE MORE OPPORTUNITY FOR INFORMAL CLASS CONTACT, E.G., THROUGH INDIVIDUAL OR SMALL GROUP MEETINGS WITH HIS STUDENTS.

THE ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES SEMESTER

IN RECOGNITION OF THE WIDESPREAD STUDENT CONCERN OVER THE GROWING ECOLOGICAL CRISIS, AN ENVIRONMENTAL SEMESTER, WHICH ENABLES THE INTERESTED STUDENT TO STUDY IN DEPTH THE MANY FACETS OF THIS CRISIS FROM THE PERSPECTIVE OF A NUMBER OF DIFFERENT DISCIPLINES, WILL BE OFFERED DURING THE SPRING SEMESTER. STUDENTS ENROLLING IN THE PROGRAM WILL TAKE THE SAME BLOC OF FOUR COURSES AND INTERDISCIPLINARY SEMINAR. THE BLOC OF COURSES CONSISTS OF BIOLOGY 111,222, EARTH SCIENCES 490, POLITICAL SCIENCE 354 AND RELIGION 430. FOUR COURSE CROBITS WILL BE GRANTED TO PARTICIPANTS, AND IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF A PHYSICAL EDUCATION OF MUSIC COURSE, THIS WILL COMPLETE THE STUDENT'S COURSE LOAD. COURSE LOAD.

THE PROGRAM WILL BE LIMITED TO 25 STUDENTS WITH PREFERENCE THE PROGRAM WILL BE LIMITED TO 25 STUDENTS WITH PREFERENCE GIVEN TO JUNIORS AND SENIORS. IF A STUDENT HAS ALREADY TAKEN ONE OF THE COURSES IN THE BLOC, AN ALTERNATE COURSE MAY BE SUBSTITUTED. HOWEVER, IT IS EXPECTED THAT WITH THIS ONE EXCEPTION, THE STUDENT WILL REGISTER FOR ALL FOUR COURSES. THIS IS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION INTO THE SEMINAR.

STUDENTS WILL MEET WITH INDIVIDUAL INSTRUCTORS FOR THE FOUR COURSES COMPRISING THE PROGRAM AND THEN ONCE A WEEK IN A SEMINAR-TYPE SITUATION WITH THE FOUR INSTRUCTORS. FIELD TRIPS WILL BE SCHEDULED THROUGHOUT THE SEMESTER, AND SINCE ALL STUDENTS WILL BE TAKING THE SAME BLOC OF COURSES, SCHEDULING PROBLEMS SHOULD NOT ARISE. STUDENTS OTHER THAN THOSE IN ESS MAY ENRULL IN ANY OF THE SEPANATE COURSES, BUT NOT IN THE SEMINAR.
