Senior Beer Fountain on Tap

Senior Class president Wipe McClean announced today that the Class of '68 has finally, after much consideration and spontaneous deliberation, decided upon its traditional gift to the University.

Several proposals were discussed before the execs called. SPU president A. B. Steinorsin suggested a 100-ton Alaric to be placed south of Krueger Hall. The idea was rejected because, as several representatives from Kruider pointed out, such a device would not be effective in solving the alleged problem. Mak Dungalo then suggested that the class purchase a \$10,000 installed all-champagne kegging system which would help make the Office of Student Affairs more efficient. It was quickly voted down but that this would be the long or short run cost more than the RP's (RP: Rights) already allocated for that purpose.

The accepted idea was a joint proposal made by a group of students known as the Drop-in Crew. Regarding the need for a more fluid social life on campus,

John the pony smashed out his teeth together and drew up the idea of a Luther inspired Beer Fountain. The rest of the crew swallowed the idea and immediately drew up a set of rules governing its use.

The fountain is to be called the Three Rings and is to be used only by persons over 21 except on Nov. 11 and Oct. 31 when everyone is invited to celebrate.

The fountain will be open for use from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 P.M. daily except when both wheels threaten the loss of valuable time. Of course only administrators, faculty and staff are permitted to use it from 9:00 to 10:30 Monday through Friday.

McClean said that the fountain was completed quickly due to the competency and skill of PLU architects (as well as the fact that certain necessary structures happened to be in the area).

When questioned about the value of the gift, McClean said: "I think this will be a very stimulating addition to campus social life. Too-

Not only have we provided the funds necessary to maintain the fountain until next year when we hope the Class of '69 will follow our sobering lead, but we have managed to provide six different brands: Monday will feature Olympus; Tuesday, Heidelberg; Wednesday, Rainier; Thursday, Lucky Logger; Friday, Spamm's; and on the week-end, that king of beers, Buddywiser."

PLU President Dr. R. R. Moredebt commented: "This is one of the most original gifts ever presented to the University. It shows a deep concern for the poeposes
