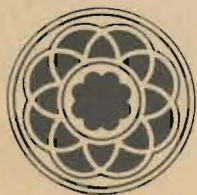

REGISTRATION

OTHERWISE THE SCN WILL BE USED. THE REGISTRAR'S OFFICE WILL INFORM YOU CONCERNING THE COURSE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER WHEN YOU REGISTER.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

PAYMENT BY SEMESTER--IF THIS OPTION IS SELECTED, THE TOTAL COST OF EACH SEMESTER MUST BE PAID BEFORE CLASSES BEGIN. THE UNIVERSITY WILL ACCEPT BANK CARDS, WITH POSITIVE IDENTIFICATION.

THE PLU BUDGET PLAN PROVIDES FOR PREPAYING THE ESTIMATED ANNUAL COSTS IN TWELVE INSTALLMENTS FROM MAY 10 THROUGH APRIL 10. FALL SEMESTER THE PAYMENT PLAN IS MAY 10 THROUGH OCTOBER 10. A BUDGET PLAN AGREEMENT MUST BE SIGNED AND ON FILE IN THE BUSINESS OFFICE.

NOTE: ENROLLMENT IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL PAYMENT IS MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ONE OF THE ABOVE OPTIONS. LATE PAYMENTS MAY BE ASSESSED A 1% MONTHLY INTEREST CHARGE ON ANY OUTSTANDING BALANCE.

V.A. BENEFITS

IF YOU EXPECT TO RECEIVE ANY TYPE OF VETERAN OR WAR ORPHAN BENEFITS, YOU MUST FILE YOUR CERTIFICATE OR ELIGIBILITY IN ROOM HA-104. FORMS AND INFORMATION CONCERNING VETERAN BENEFITS ARE AVAILABLE IN ROOM HA-104. MAKE APPLICATION WHEN REGISTERING. AN UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT MUST BE REGISTERED FOR 12 SEMESTER HOURS AND A GRADUATE STUDENT FOR 8 SEMESTER HOURS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FULL-TIME V.A. BENEFITS.

INDEPENDENT STUDY, RESEARCH, THESIS

SPECIAL STUDY SUCH AS INDEPENDENT STUDY, RESEARCH, SPECIAL PROJECTS, STUDIO PROJECTS, THESIS, AND GRADUATE READINGS ARE AVAILABLE IN MOST DEPARTMENTS. STUDENTS ARE ADVISED TO READ THE CATALOG AND CONTACT EACH DEPARTMENT FOR DETAILS. AN INDEPENDENT STUDY CARD MUST ACCOMPANY EACH REGISTRATION FOR SPECIAL STUDY. CARDS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE REGISTRAR'S OFFICE.

REFUND POLICY

A FULL TUITION REFUND (LESS \$25.00 WITHDRAWAL FEE) WILL BE MADE FOR FALL AND SPRING SEMESTERS WHEN A STUDENT WITHDRAWS FROM THE UNIVERSITY BEFORE THE END OF THE SECOND WEEK; 25% TUITION REFUNDS WILL BE MADE FOR WITHDRAWALS DURING THE THIRD AND FOURTH WEEKS; NO REFUNDS ARE ALLOWED AFTER THE FOURTH WEEK.

A FULL TUITION REFUND WILL BE MADE FOR ANY REDUCTION IN LOAD DURING THE FIRST 10 CLASS DAYS OF EACH TERM. THERE IS NO TUITION REFUND AFTER THE 10TH CLASS DAY.

DROP/ADD FEE

CHANGES OF REGISTRATION WILL BE ACCEPTED BEGINNING AUGUST 18 - SEPTEMBER 5 AND AGAIN SEPTEMBER 9 - SEPTEMBER 22. A GRACE PERIOD, WHEN NO DROP/ADD FEE IS CHARGED, CONTINUES THROUGH THE FIRST WEEK OF CLASS (SEPT. 9-15). AFTER THAT, A FEE OF \$5.00 WILL BE CHARGED FOR ANY REGISTRATION CHANGE THAT DOES NOT INCREASE THE TOTAL NUMBER OF CREDIT HOURS.
